



IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

To: All Ember Recreational Vehicle Dealers

February 20, 2026

Ember Recreational Vehicles, Inc., (“Ember”) has decided that select 2026 Overland and E-Series recreational vehicles fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No.567, “Certification”.

The affected units were manufactured between July 24, 2025 and December 19, 2025. The VINs of units affected are:

**Ember Overland Series 7RVTV2268TA003605 to 7RVTE2273TA003913 (non-sequential)
Ember E-Series 7RVTE1167TA003610 to 7RVTE2273TA003939 (non-sequential)**

Our records indicate the following affected units are in your possession:

On select Ember trailers, the certification label has an incorrect Unloaded Vehicle Weight and Cargo Carrying Capacity listed, which can allow the recreational vehicle to be overloaded with cargo. An overloaded trailer increases the risk of a crash.

Owners of the affected vehicles will be notified of this recall by mail from Ember. A copy of the Owner Notification Letter is attached. Also attached are the repair instructions associated with this recall action.

Please be reminded that it is a violation of Federal Law for you to sell or lease the products covered by this notification until the necessary repairs have been performed. Substantial civil penalties apply to violations of this law. Your assistance with this recall is appreciated.
