Repair Available – Safety Recall 90TW / Lane Departure Warning System Software

This notice is for: All Dealer Personnel

Date: March 06, 2026

Issue: The software remedy for a small number of vehicles repaired under compliance recall 90TV incorrectly contained coding that inadvertently removed the virtual button & icon for the lane departure warning system. Under these specific circumstances, the missing virtual button and icon may increase the risk of driver confusion regarding the functionality and capabilities of the vehicle's lane departure warning system. If the driver overlooks other warnings, instructions, and traffic behavior, this may increase the risk of a crash.

- Repair:**
- REPAIR AVAILABLE – March 06, 2026 - Software update to reactivate the virtual button & icon for the lane departure warning system.
 - See ELSA and Service References in Elsa2Go for complete repair & claiming instructions.
 - Check daily campaign open inventory report or OMD for affected vehicles in inventory.
 - Repair every affected inventory vehicle before delivery to consumers.

IMPORTANT REMINDER ON VEHICLES AFFECTED BY SAFETY & COMPLIANCE RECALLS

USA Dealers - New Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: It is a violation of federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. By law, dealers must correct, prior to delivery for sale or lease, any vehicle that fails to comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or that contains a defect relating to motor vehicle safety.

All Dealers - Pre-Owned Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: Dealers should not deliver any pre-owned vehicles in their inventory which are involved in a safety or compliance recall until the defect has been remedied.
