From: Product Safety and Certification**Subject:** Recall RVXX2603 Cluster may go blank**Description of Defect:**

Certain Volvo VNL (4) vehicles may be equipped with instrument clusters that could go blank while driving. As a result, the subject vehicles do not comply with the visibility and illumination requirements of FMVSS 101, §§ S5.1.2. An Instrument cluster that does not display critical information, such as vehicle speed or telltales, can increase the risk of a crash.

Models/ Model Years Affected:

Certain MY 2025- 2026 VNL (4) model vehicles manufactured from July 18, 2024 through January 27, 2025.

Vehicle Quantities:

143 (115 US, 28 Canada, 0 Mexico and 0 Export)

Dealer's Responsibility:

The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Act require dealers to ensure that all new and used vehicles are free of safety defects and comply with all relevant safety standards at the time of delivery to the consumer.

Dealers should make their personnel aware of the safety recall. In the event that a dealer has a vehicle included in the safety recall in their inventory to be sold, the condition must be corrected before releasing it to a customer.

Release Schedule:

- Vehicle list will be posted on the Trucks Dealer Portal 4/1/2026.
- Owner notification letters will be released on or before 5/17/2026.
- Repair instruction will be released once they are available.
