Subject:	RVXX2602 Service Brake Release Timing			

Description of Defect:

Volvo VNL (4) vehicles built with a specific configuration of rear suspension, rear axle arrangement, brake chamber size and traction control do not meet FMVSS 121 (S5.3.4) release timing requirements. The specified vehicles do not meet the brake release timing requirement of a maximum of 0.55 seconds, with testing showing 0.61 seconds. While a non-compliant brake release timing may increase crash risk, the condition is not noticeable to the driver.

Models/ Model Years Affected:

Certain MY 2025-2026 VNL (4) model vehicles manufactured from 5/28/2024 through 12/11/2025.

Vehicle Quantities:

282 (222 US, 60 Canada)

Dealer's Responsibility:

The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Act require dealers to ensure that all new and used vehicles are free of safety defects and comply with all relevant safety standards at the time of delivery to the consumer.

Dealers should make their personnel aware of the safety recall. In the event that a dealer has a vehicle included in the safety recall in their inventory to be sold, the condition must be corrected before releasing it to a customer.

Release Schedule:

- Vehicle list will be posted on the Trucks Dealer Portal 4/01/2026.
- Owner notification letters will be released on or before 5/24/2026.
- Repair instruction will be released once they are available.
