Issue	Mercedes-Benz AG, the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has decided that a defect exists on certain subject vehicles, in which the wheel bolts might not meet current production specifications. The wheel bolts' connection to the wheel hub might loosen while driving. This could impair driving stability, which could increase the risk of a crash		
What We're Doing	MBUSA will conduct a voluntary recall. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will replace the wheel bolts on the affected vehicles with a new bolt variant.		
Remedy	The remedy is not available at this time.		
Launch Date	Affected VINs will be flagged in VMI as "PENDING" on Thursday, April 2, 2026. The campaign will be visible on the www.NHTSA.gov website and may generate questions from customers.		

Given this notice, it is a violation of federal law for a dealer to sell or lease any new vehicle in dealer inventory covered by this notification until the vehicle has been repaired. Violations of federal law may result in civil penalties.

- Loaner and demonstrator vehicles may continue to be driven, but must not be retailed until repaired.
- Once the remedy is available, vehicles will be flagged as "OPEN" and Work Instructions will be available.
- As a matter of normal service process, please check for other repair measures that might be applicable to the vehicle(s).
