From: Product Safety and Certification**Subject:** RVXX2604 No Trailer Turn Signal**Description of Defect:**

Certain Volvo VNL (4) and VNR (4) models may be equipped with software that does not provide adequate current to support incandescent trailer turn signal indicators. As a result, the subject vehicles do not comply with FMVSS No. 108 S7.1.2 rear turn signal lamps.

If a trailer is operated with inoperative trailer turn signal indicators, vehicles around the trailer would not be able to observe or anticipate when the trailer is turning or changing lanes, which could increase the risk of a crash.

Models/ Model Years Affected:

Certain MY 2025 – 2027 VNL (4) and VNR (4) model vehicles manufactured from January 15, 2024, through March 13, 2026.

Vehicle Quantities:

352 (336 US, 16 Canada)

Dealer's Responsibility:

The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Act require dealers to ensure that all new and used vehicles are free of safety defects and comply with all relevant safety standards at the time of delivery to the consumer.

Dealers should make their personnel aware of the safety recall. In the event that a dealer has a vehicle included in the safety recall in their inventory to be sold, the condition must be corrected before releasing it to a customer.

Release Schedule:

- Vehicle list will be posted on the Trucks Dealer Portal 4/8/2026.
- Owner notification letters will be released on or before 5/31/2026.
- Repair instruction will be released once they are available.
