



New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – 47D

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2026 model year (WS) Jeep Grand Wagoneer and Grand Wagoneer L vehicles.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles may have been reworked after the normal assembly process was complete and may not have had the front camera wire harness reconnected after the rework. A disconnected camera harness may result in the Rear View Camera (RVC) image not displaying in a backing event. Failure to display a rearview image can increase the risk of a crash.

The condition described above does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 571.111 S6.2.6 requires that "The rear visibility system default to the rearview image being visible and meet the requirements of FMVSS No. 571.111 S6.2.1 (field of view) and S6.2.2 (image size) at the beginning of each backing event, regardless of any modifications to the field of view that the driver had previously selected..." Suspect vehicles may not display the default rearview image during a backing event.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall for all affected vehicles to inspect and, if necessary, connect the front camera harness. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 2nd Quarter of 2026.
