



New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – 46D

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2019 and 2023 Model Year (RU) Chrysler Pacifica, 2024 Model Year (DT) Ram 1500 and 2024 and 2025 Model Year (JL) Jeep® Wrangler vehicles.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles may have been built with an improperly programmed Central Vision Processing Module (CVPM) which may prevent the rearview camera image from displaying. A rearview image that does not display reduces the driver's view of what is behind the vehicle which can increase the risk of a crash.

The condition described above does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 571.111 S6.2.6 which requires that "The rear visibility system default to the rearview image...at the beginning of each backing event, regardless of any modifications to the field of view that the driver had previously selected."

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to update the CVPM software or install a new CVPM. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 2nd Quarter of 2026.
