Re: Stop Sale/Safety Recall: 2014-2020 MDX Rear Subframe Corrosion

On June 4, 2026, Acura notified NHTSA of a **stop sale** and **safety recall** for certain 2014-2020 MDX vehicles. In salt-belt states, de-icing agents used to maintain roadways may adhere to the rear subframe. Prolonged exposure can result in corrosion, which may cause the control arm and/or lower arm to detach, increasing the risk of a crash or injury. **Refer to your eResponsibility report or perform an iN VIN status inquiry to determine which units in your inventory are affected.**

REPAIR

Install the rear subframe reinforcement kit.

PARTS

Parts will be available at launch through the normal parts ordering system.

TOOLS

Air Riveters and Rivnut Installers have been sent to the service managers at dealerships.

SERVICE BULLETIN

Service Bulletin 26-049, *Safety Recall: 2014-20 MDX Rear Subframe Reinforcement Kit* has posted to the Service Information System (SIS) as of June 5, 2026. It includes parts, tools, repair, and warranty claim information related to this recall.

CLIENT NOTIFICATION

Acura expects to begin client notification in early July 2026.

As always, perform an iN VIN status inquiry for all vehicles passing through your dealership to determine eligibility for any open campaigns.
