Re: Stop Sale/Safety Recall: 2023-26 Multi-Model Tire Repair Kit

On June 4, 2026, American Honda notified NHTSA of a **stop sale** and **safety recall** for certain 2023-2026 Accord Hybrid, 2023-2026 CR-V Hybrid, and 2025-2026 CR-V e:FCEV vehicles. Incorrect usage of the tire repair kit may cause pressure buildup, which could lead to a canister rupture and the risk of injury. **Refer to your eResponsibility report or perform an iN VIN status inquiry to determine which units in your inventory are affected.**

REPAIR

Replace the sealant hose valve or the tire sealant bottle.

PARTS

An initial parts allocation has already been provided to your dealer. Parts availability will be limited at launch, and additional allocations will be distributed over the next three weeks, after which parts will move to a controlled ordering process. For the latest information, refer to iN > Service > Parts and Service News Flash > National.

TOOLS

There are no special tools required for this recall.

SERVICE BULLETIN

Service Bulletin 26-084, *Safety Recall: 2025-26 CR-V e:FCEV, 2023-26 Accord FHEV/CR-V FHEV Tire Repair Kit Hose Valve* has posted to the Service Information System (SIS) as of June 5, 2026. It includes parts, repair, and warranty claim information related to this recall.

CUSTOMER NOTIFICATION

American Honda expects to begin customer notification in late July 2026.
