Background:

Vermeer has decided that a defect that relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model year 2003 – 2026 Vermeer BC1800XL brush chippers.

UNINTENDED HYDRAULIC JACK EXTENSION

A failure can occur resulting in the extension of the hydraulic jack without input from the operator.

DEATH OR SERIOUS INJURY POSSIBLE

When towing the brush chipper on public roadways, **death or serious injury** is possible if the hydraulic jack contacts the ground and causes loss of vehicle control, which may increase the risk of a crash, or if the hydraulic jack becomes separated and strikes another vehicle or pedestrian. Property damage is also possible.

Solution:

IMMEDIATE MACHINE MODIFICATIONS REQUIRED

IK004837 has been created to provide the necessary parts and instructions to prevent the unintended lowering of the hydraulic jack. **This kit must be installed as soon as possible.**

Please be reminded that it is a violation of federal law for you to sell or lease the machines covered by this notification until this recall has been performed on these machines. Substantial civil penalties apply to violations of this law.

2. **Dealership orders kits** by entering the order into EzParts. Each dealership should determine the quantity of kits to order initially depending upon the number of units that may be available for immediate upgrade. **Do not order more kits than needed for immediate installation.**
3. **Contact your affected customer(s)** to schedule a mutually acceptable time to upgrade their machine. **Note:** Letters will be sent to the customer(s) on or about **August 7, 2026**. *Also refer to Owner Notification section below.*
4. **Review dealer parts inventory** for affected part(s) as follows:

For Part # 163755632 – Start Switch, dispose of the part(s) in dealer inventory by simply throwing them away.

For Part # 151239001 – Pump – DC Power 3GPM@500PSI/RV@2500, remove and dispose of Part # 163755632 – Start Switch from the assembly. Replace with Part # 163866037.

REIMBURSEMENT

Kit installation. Upon completion of each kit installation, a campaign warranty claim must be submitted to the warranty department for reimbursement of the cost of parts and labor to install the kit. Labor hours to install: 2 hours. Destruction and disposal of the part(s) listed above are included in the labor hours. No additional reimbursement will be paid.

Dealer parts inventory. If the dealer has parts in dealer inventory to dispose of per section 4 above, submit a standard warranty claim to request RMA from warranty department. Reference IK004837 in causal part number field.

Travel will be paid up to \$200 (\$1 per mile with a \$200 max round trip) with copy of work order attached for retailed machines not in dealer inventory. If dealer repairs more than one machine at same location on one trip, travel will only be paid on one of the model/VINs.

Note: Future notices to dealers and owners are dependent upon the receipt of warranty claims.

If the Vermeer dealer travels to the unit to install the kit, costs may be incurred by the owner. **You must have your machine upgraded for these safety features.**

Valid claims will be reimbursed once your complete reimbursement and repair information has been verified and recorded in our system.
