MaxxAir Fan Printed Circuit Board May Overheat

Dear Tiffin Motorhome Dealer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Tiffin Motorhomes has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in the following models of motorhomes, **2026 and 2027 Allegro Bay Motorhomes, 2026 Allegro Breeze Motorhomes, 2026 and 2027 Allegro Bus motorhomes, 2026 and 2027 Allegro Open Road Motorhomes, 2026 and 2027 Allegro RED Motorhomes, 2026 Byway Motorhomes, 2026 and 2027 GT1 Motorhomes, 2026 Midas Motorhomes, 2026 & 2027 Open Trail Motorhomes, 2026 and 2027 Phaeton Motorhomes, 2026 and 2027 Wayfarer Motorhomes and 2026 and 2027 Zephyr Motorhomes built between January 12, 2026, and June 19, 2026.**

On motorhomes that are equipped with the MaxxAir brand of roof vent fans, the printed circuit board installed in the fan contains a safety defect that can result in the overheating of the printed circuit board. A printed circuit board that overheats may result in a fire.

The defective printed circuit boards will be replaced with updated printed circuit boards that do not contain the defect.

To eliminate any chance of the MaxxAir vent fan overheating, it is recommended that the fans not be operated until the recall repair is completed.

Owners will be notified by mail about the recall and instructed to take their motorhome to a reputable service center **OR** dealer of **their** choice to have the repair completed. RVP is allowing 15 minutes per fan for inspection and an additional 15 minutes per fan for replacement of the printed circuit board if needed.

The recall kit for this recall must be ordered from RVP. Tiffin Motorhomes will **NOT** be shipping recall kits, providing authorization for work, or processing warranty claims for payment. Please verify the motorhome is involved in this recall **before** beginning the repair. To verify a motorhome's involvement in this recall, please visit our website, www.tiffinmotorhomes.com. Choose the "Dealer Login" page and click on "Vehicle Recall Lookup" and enter the complete 17-digit VIN number. No login or password is needed.

Please be reminded that it is a violation of Federal law for you to sell or lease any new Tiffin Motorhome covered by this notification until this recall has been performed on the motorhome. Substantial civil penalties apply to violations of this law.

We regret any inconvenience this action may cause but feel certain you understand our interest in motor vehicle safety.
