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## **New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – 50D**

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2026 Model Year (WS) Jeep® Grand Wagoneer and Grand Wagoneer L vehicles.

### **REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL**

Some of the above vehicles may have been built with a Brake System Control Module (BSCM) with suspect software which may disable Electronic Stability Control (ESC) and may lose electronic brake assist. A loss of ESC function and/or electronic brake assist can cause a vehicle crash without prior warning.

The condition described above does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 126 S5.1.2 which requires that the Electronic Stability Control (ESC) "is operational during all phases of driving including acceleration, coasting, and deceleration (including braking)...." A BSCM with suspect software may not allow proper ESC function during all phases of driving.

The condition described above also does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 135 S7 which requires certain testing to be performed using the specified test methods. Suspect vehicles may lose electronic brake assist and be unable to meet the performance requirements of FMVSS No. 135.

### **SERVICE ACTION**

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to update the BSCM software. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 3rd Quarter of 2026.
