



ADVANCE DEALER NOTICE OF SAFETY RECALL

DATE	7/6/2026
RECALL ID	Kia: SC374 / NHTSA: <i>TBD</i>
SUBJECT	Kia is conducting a safety recall to address an issue involving the front power seats.
AFFECTED VEHICLES	Certain 2020-2024 MY Telluride vehicles, manufactured from January 9, 2019 through May 29, 2024, that were previously affected by SC316 (NHTSA: 24V407).
AFFECTED POPULATION	Approximately 462,869 vehicles
RECALL CONDITION	An external impact with excessive force to the front power seat side cover and/or seat slide knob in the subject vehicles may cause the power seat switch to become dislodged, internally misaligned, or otherwise damaged. A misaligned or damaged seat switch, or an improper recall SC316 (24V407) repair, may lead to continuous operation of a seat motor. Over time, this can result in overheating of a seat motor, thereby increasing the risk of a fire while driving or while parked.
REMEDY	To install an electronic fuse assembly to prevent continuous operation of a seat motor if the seat switch becomes dislodged, internally misaligned, or otherwise damaged.
REMEDY AVAILABILITY	Early August 2026
PLANNED NOTIFICATIONS	Dealers will be notified early August 2026. Owners will be notified by first-class mail beginning mid-August 2026.
IMPORTANT/WARNING	Vehicle owners will be instructed to park the vehicle outside and away from structures until the repair has been performed.
NHTSA ADVISORY	It is a violation of Federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect is remedied.
