



ADVANCE DEALER NOTICE OF SAFETY RECALL

RECALL ID	Kia: SC375 / NHTSA: <i>TBD</i>
SUBJECT	Kia is conducting a safety recall to address an issue involving the high-voltage battery system assembly.
AFFECTED VEHICLES	7 units of 2022-2024 MY EV6 vehicles manufactured from December 30, 2021 through September 14, 2023 and 1 unit of 2024 MY EV9 vehicle manufactured on October 28, 2023.
AFFECTED POPULATION	8 vehicles
RECALL CONDITION	Due to a quality deviation by the supplier, certain battery cells within the High-Voltage Battery System assembly, manufactured in limited production periods, may have been produced with a misaligned electrode. A misaligned electrode may, over time, result in an internal short circuit in certain situations, thereby increasing the risk of fire. A fire increases the risk of injury.
REMEDY	To replace the high-voltage battery system assembly with a new one.
REMEDY AVAILABILITY	Late July 2026
PLANNED NOTIFICATIONS	Dealers will be notified late July 2026. Owners will be notified by first-class mail beginning early August 2026.
IMPORTANT/WARNING	Vehicle owners will be instructed to: 1. Limit battery pack charging to 80% state of charge 2. Park their vehicle outdoors and away from other vehicles or structures until the repair has been performed
NHTSA ADVISORY	It is a violation of Federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect is remedied.
