Certain 2026 model year Volvo VN, VHD, VAH, VNE, VNL (4) and VNR (4) vehicles may have been built with steering knuckles that have insufficient torque on steering arm fasteners. The loosening of a steering arm could result in a loss of steering, increasing the risk of a crash or injury

Models/ Model Years Affected:

Certain MY 2026 VN, VHD, VAH, VNE, VNL (4) and VNR (4) model vehicles manufactured from February 3, 2025, through July 24, 2025.

Vehicle Quantities:

4,339 (3,794 US, 545 Canada)

Dealer's Responsibility:

The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Act require dealers to ensure that all new and used vehicles are free of safety defects and comply with all relevant safety standards at the time of delivery to the consumer.

Dealers should make their personnel aware of the safety recall. In the event that a dealer has a vehicle included in the safety recall in their inventory to be sold, the condition must be corrected before releasing it to a customer.

Release Schedule:

- Vehicle list will be posted on the Trucks Dealer Portal 7/15/2026.
- Owner notification letters will be released on or before 9/7/2026.
- Repair instruction will be released once they are available.
