**Re: R26B1 2020-2026 Armada Certification Label (GAWR) Recall –
Affected Dealer Used Vehicle Inventory and Nissan Certified Pre-
Owned (CPO) Vehicles**

Nissan has determined that a recall affecting certain Nissan Armada vehicles involves an incorrect Gross Axle Weight Rating (GAWR) displayed on the Federal Certification Label. To remedy this condition, Nissan intends to provide corrected label overlays for installation over the existing certification label.

Due to material and print production constraints, remedy labels are not yet available for pre-owned vehicles. Affected vehicles currently remain in an **OPEN - Remedy Not Yet Available status**.

Nissan recognizes this situation may affect dealer-owned used vehicle inventory, including vehicles eligible for the Nissan Certified Pre-Owned (CPO) Program. Until remedy labels become available, dealers may follow the process outlined below when selling affected used vehicles.

USED VEHICLE INVENTORY & NISSAN CPO

For affected used and Nissan CPO Program vehicles in dealer inventory **(DO NOT USE THIS DISCLOSURE FORM FOR NEW VEHICLE INVENTORY)**:

1. Confirm Recall Status

- Verify that the R26B1 Certification Label (GAWR) recall is the only open recall on the vehicle.
- Complete any additional open recalls or campaigns prior to vehicle sale.

2. Disclose the Open Recall

- Inform the customer that the vehicle is subject to the R26B1 Certification Label (GAWR) recall.

- Review the R26B1 Nissan Non-Compliance Recall Information Sheet with the customer.
- Have the customer sign the provided disclosure form acknowledging:
 - The recall remains open.
 - The remedy is not currently available.
 - Nissan will mail owners the corrective certification label overlay when it is available.

3. Retain Documentation

- Maintain signed disclosure documentation with vehicle sales records.
 - Provide a copy to Nissan by emailing the completed disclosure form to NNAFQASUPPORT@Nissan-USA.com with **R26B1 Completed Disclosure in the subject line.**

Dealer Reminder

Affected dealer inventory vehicles remain subject to all applicable federal, state, and local requirements. Dealers should ensure all disclosure obligations are satisfied and that all documentation is properly maintained.

Nissan will mail the corrective certification label overlay to owners once it becomes available.

Nissan Non-Compliance Recall: *R26B1; NHTSA Recall ID 26V-455*

Nissan North America has initiated a non-compliance recall for 2020-2026 Model Year Nissan Armada vehicles equipped with optional 22-inch wheels due to incorrect information listed on the certification label.

DESCRIPTION OF THE DEFECT AND SAFETY RISK

The Certification Label located on the driver's side door pillar near the door latch of your vehicle may contain incorrect Gross Axle Weight Rating (GAWR) information required by CFR 49 Part 567; "Certification" and with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 110; "Tire Selection and Rims." Having the correct GAWR information on the Certification label is important because overloading your vehicle may increase the risk of a crash.

WHAT WILL NISSAN DO

Nissan is currently preparing labels to remedy your vehicle. Beginning this Fall 2026, Nissan will mail a new overlay label that contains the corrected GAWR value for your vehicle and include instructions on how to affix it to your existing Certification Label.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

Do not reference GAWR values listed on your Certification Label. While your new overlay label is on order, please refer to the information below for the correct GAWR values for your Nissan Armada vehicle:
