



New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – 67D

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2019-2026 model year (DT) Ram 1500 Pickup trucks.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles may have been built with a second-row center and/or second-row driver side seat belt buckle anchor not properly attached to the body structure, which may result in reduced occupant restraint capabilities. Reduced load management by the seat belt buckle may result in injury to vehicle occupants in certain types of driving conditions or crashes.

The condition described above does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 571.210 S4.2.4 requires that, "Anchorages, attachment hardware, and attachment bolts shall be tested by simultaneously loading them in accordance with the applicable procedures "[...]". A seat belt buckle anchor not properly fastened may reduce load management capability and occupant restraint effectiveness.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall on all affected vehicles to inspect and, if necessary, attach the second-row seat belt buckle anchor to the body structure. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 3rd Quarter of 2026.
