New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – 61D

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2021 through 2023 Model Year (WD) Dodge Durango vehicles.

VINs identified as being involved in this campaign are currently live and searchable.
Stop sale is in effect for the above-identified vehicles.

Vehicles impacted by a stop sale are eligible for reimbursement allowance through the Recall Floorplan Reimbursement Policy (RFPRP), which can be requested upon recall claim submission.

IMPORTANT: Some of the involved vehicles may be in dealer new vehicle inventory. Federal law requires you to complete this recall service on these vehicles before retail delivery. Violation of this requirement by a dealer could result in a civil penalty of up to \$27,874 per vehicle. Involved vehicles can be determined by using the VIP inquiry process.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles were built with rear spoilers that may be over-flush to the roof, allowing contact to the roof when cycling the liftgate. An over-flush rear spoiler may become damaged when cycling the liftgate which may result in the spoiler becoming detached from the vehicle. Rear spoilers which detach from a vehicle may create road debris and increase the risk of a vehicle crash.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall on all affected vehicles. The remedy is under development. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods.

We ask that you please take the time to ensure that your personnel are aware of this communication and are prepared to execute a customer friendly process for inquiries regarding involved vehicles.
