New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – 69D

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2025 through 2026 Model Year (RU) Chrysler Voyager, 2026 Model Year Chrysler Pacifica Plug-In Hybrid Electric (PHEV) and 2025 through 2026 Model Year Chrysler Pacifica vehicles.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles may be equipped with a brake pedal position sensor that has a cracked capacitor which may cause the Electronic Stability Control (ESC) light to illuminate and disable the ESC system. Failure of the ESC system when intervention is expected and/or relied upon can cause a vehicle crash without prior warning.

The condition described above does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 126 - Electronic stability control systems for light vehicles requires, in S5.1.2 that vehicles to which this standard applies must be equipped with an electronic stability control system that is operational during all phases of driving including acceleration, coasting, and deceleration. The suspect vehicles were built with brake pedal position sensors that may have a cracked capacitor which may disable the ESC system, thus preventing the system from being operational during all phases of driving.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to inspect, and if necessary, replace the brake pedal position sensor. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 3rd Quarter of 2026.
