New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – 89D

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2022 and 2023 Model Year (WL) Jeep Grand Cherokee, 2021 through 2023 Model Year Jeep Grand Cherokee L and 2022 and 2023 Model Year Jeep Grand Cherokee Plug-In Hybrid Electric (PHEV) vehicles with coil spring rear suspension, and not equipped with air spring suspension (sales code SER).

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles may may experience a rear coil spring that may not be correctly installed, allowing the coil spring to come out of position and, possibly, detach from the vehicle while driving. A rear coil spring that detaches from the vehicle while driving creates a road hazard to operators and occupants of other vehicles, and can cause a vehicle crash without prior warning and/or may result in injury to other road users.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall on all affected vehicles to replace both rear coil spring lower isolators. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 3rd Quarter of 2026.
