### IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

THIS NOTICE APPLIES TO YOUR VEHICLE, VIN: 7SYEA3YB0SG000000

**NHTSA Recall No. 26V-037**

Dear Polestar Owner,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

#### The reason for Recall RP1079:

Polestar Performance AB has decided that certain model year 2025 Polestar 3 vehicles fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) number 207, "Seating Systems." The striker brackets that secure the rear seat backrest may be loose.

A loose rear seat backrest may fall forward and allow cargo to enter the cabin during a crash, increasing the risk of injury.

#### What should you do now?

The remedy, which will be free-of-charge to you, will be for your service point to inspect and tighten the rear seat backrest striker bracket mounting nuts as necessary.

Please contact your authorized Service Point to schedule an appointment for this recall repair to be completed. This procedure can take up to (1) one hour to complete, however due to service scheduling your Service Point may require your vehicle for a longer period.

If you no longer own the vehicle described in this letter, please help us to update our records by sending us the updated owner information. Please refer to our contact information in this letter.

If you had previously paid for this repair to be performed, prior to receiving this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy for the problem associated with this recall.
