

IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL 26501

THIS NOTICE APPLIES TO YOUR VEHICLE IDENTIFIED ON THE ENCLOSED CARD.

Dear International customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

International Motors, LLC* has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2026 and 2027 International® MV™ Series trucks built 11/13/2025 thru 12/08/2025, with Bendix® Fusion™ 3.0 Collision Mitigation, ACC Stop & Driver Go (feature code 0008TRM), and Allison 2000 or 3000 Series™ Generation 6 Transmission (feature codes 0013BAU, 0013BAV, 0013BBA, 0013BBG, 0013BBJ, 0013BBK, 0013BCS and 0013BDR).

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

In Adaptive Cruise Control (ACC) mode, the vehicle does not apply service brakes to decelerate or maintain a stationary brake hold (Stop & Driver Go).

RISK TO MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY

If the service brakes do not activate during an ACC braking event, stopping distance can increase without warning, increasing the risk of a crash, personal injury, or death.

DEFECT REMEDY

The remedy will involve reprogramming the air brake electronic control unit (ECU) with the latest software revision. The repair will be performed free of charge and take approximately 30 minutes to complete.

ACTIONS YOU SHOULD TAKE

Until the vehicle is updated to the latest software revision, drivers should refrain from using cruise control.

If you own this vehicle, please schedule an appointment with any authorized repair center to have your vehicle repaired at no cost to you. Love's and Speedco locations in Texas and Louisiana cannot perform warranty services.

If you have already paid for repairs prior to this notice that corrected this defect, you may be eligible for reimbursement of certain repair expenses if they occurred 11/13/2025 thru 04/30/2026. Present your original repair paperwork and proof of payment to any International® dealer and your

eligibility will be reviewed. You may also submit a claim using the enclosed Request for Reimbursement card.

If you are the lessor of this vehicle, please forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days to comply with federal regulations.

If you do not own this vehicle, please fill out and return mail the enclosed card so that you will not be contacted again about this recall.

IF YOU NEED FURTHER ASSISTANCE
