IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL 26502

THIS NOTICE APPLIES TO YOUR VEHICLE IDENTIFIED ON THE ENCLOSED CARD.

Dear IC Bus Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

IC Bus has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2023 thru 2027 IC Bus™ CE Series school buses built 12/15/2022 thru 02/02/2026 with Hydraulic Brake (feature code 0004100).

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Vehicles may have been built with incorrect mounting hardware securing the brake line assembly. Deformation in the retainer may allow the brake line to disengage and contact the steering shaft.

RISK TO MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY

Contact between the brake line and steering shaft may result in a leak in the hydraulic brake system. A leak in the hydraulic brake system can result in a soft pedal and in an emergency stop situation may increase the vehicle stopping distance possibly resulting in a vehicle crash.

DEFECT REMEDY

The repair will involve inspecting the brake line for damage, replacing the brake lines if damaged and replacing brake line retainers. The repair will be performed free of charge and take approximately 30 minutes to 3 hours to complete.

ACTIONS YOU SHOULD TAKE

If you own this vehicle, please schedule an appointment with any IC Bus dealer to have your vehicle repaired. You can find your nearest dealer by using the dealer locator at <http://www.icbus.com> or by calling 1-800-448-7825.

If you have already paid for repairs prior to this notice that corrected the defect, you may be eligible for reimbursement of certain repair expenses if they occurred 12/15/2022 thru 04/30/2025. Present your original repair paperwork and proof of payment to any IC Bus dealer and your eligibility will be reviewed. You may also submit a claim using the enclosed Request for Reimbursement card.

If you are the lessor of this vehicle, please forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days to comply with federal regulations.

If you do not own this vehicle, please fill out and return mail the enclosed card so that you will not be contacted again about this recall.

IF YOU NEED ASSISTANCE

If you believe that IC Bus has failed to remedy the defect without charge or within a reasonable time, please follow the procedure described in the Owner Assistance Guide section in your Owner's Manual or call toll free 1-800-448-7825.
