a Storyteller Overland GXV HILT, with the VIN shown below.**

NHTSA Recall: 26V-183

Your Vehicle Identification Number (VIN):

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Storyteller Overland, LLC has decided that a safety defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2024-2026 Storyteller GXV HILT vehicles, including the VIN shown above.

We apologize for any inconvenience and want to assure you that, with your assistance, we will correct this. Our commitment, along with your dealers, is to provide you with the highest level of customer service.

OWNERS CAN CONTINUE TO USE THEIR. HOWEVER, PLEASE USE THE STAIR LOCKOUT SWITCH THAT IS LOCATED IN THE FIRST CARGO BAY EVERYTIME YOU DRIVE UNTIL THE RECALL REPAIR IS COMPLETE.

What is the issue? Storyteller Overland is recalling certain 2024-2026 Storyteller GXV HILT vehicles. Storyteller GXV HILT vehicles may contain a door switch failure that could signal entry steps to automatically extend while the vehicle is in transit.

What is the risk? If the entry steps extend during transit, it potentially creates a road or pedestrian hazard, increasing the risk of a crash.

What will Storyteller Overland and your dealer do? Storyteller Overland authorized dealers will install a ground signal to the door switch circuit that is activated when the transmission is in Drive or Reverse, free of charge. This ground signal will override the door switch input and prohibit step deployment under these conditions.

How long will it take? The time needed to complete this recall will be approximately 2 hours. However, due to service scheduling requirements, your dealer may need your vehicle for a longer period of time.

What should you do? Please contact your local Storyteller Overland authorized dealer without delay and request a service date for NHTSA Recall: 26V-183. Provide the dealer with your VIN, which is printed near the top of this letter. Please email service@storytelleroverland.com when your appointment is scheduled and Storyteller Overland will make sure your dealer has everything needed to complete the update in advance.

What if you have already paid for this repair? If you have already paid for these repairs, please contact Storyteller Overland at service@storytelleroverland.com with the details of the repair including pictures of the completed repair and remedied part as well as a labor sheet or invoice. Once we have received proof of satisfactory completion and your invoice, we will coordinate reimbursement. There are no time frame or eligibility restrictions to get reimbursed for this repair.

What if you no longer own this vehicle? You received this notice because government regulations require that we send notifications to the last known owner of record. If you no longer own this vehicle, and have an address for the current owner, please forward this letter to the new owner.

Please note: Federal law requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.
