This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the **National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act**. Roadtrek Inc. has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2024-2026 Westfalia Wave SL, 2022-2026 Zion Slumber, Play Slumber, 2026 Play Tuff SL, 2025-2026 Play+Slumber, and 2024 Pivot Slumber recreational vehicles. The pop-top latch misalignment exists in all Roadtrek & Westfalia “with pop-top option” vehicles manufactured from 27th April 2022 through 06th April 2026.

Roadtrek Inc. has issued **Recall ID 2026-01** for Roadtrek & Westfalia vehicles with pop-top latch misalignment issue. A disengaged/misaligned pop-top latch may result in the secondary safety retaining straps to retain the pop-top position during travel.

In the event the pop-top opens and detaches, it could separate from the motor home, becoming a road hazard and increasing the risk of a crash for others.

The **Corrective Action** requires that you contact a Roadtrek/Westfalia Dealer of your choice to arrange to get the safety latch and safety straps replaced. To locate a dealer or service center call [1-888-762-3873] or www.roadtrek.com/locators. The dealer to contact Roadtrek Inc. to obtain the latch, the straps and the hardware, then book an appointment with you to have the repair performed. Please be assured that the repair will be performed at no cost to you. This remedy will take approximately ½ hour. We regret any inconvenience these actions may cause.

If you have had this repair performed before you received this letter you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall. **For more information, please contact Roadtrek Inc., at 1-888-762-3873.**
