This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Keystone RV Company has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model 2025-2026 Alpine, 2024 Cougar, 2026 Montana, 2026 Walkabout Fifth Wheels and Travel Trailers. As a result, Keystone RV is conducting a safety recall. We apologize for any inconvenience this action may cause you; however your safety and continued satisfaction are of the utmost importance to us.

***Reason for this recall***

It has been decided that the vehicles in the recall population may have improperly torqued shock bolts. Improperly torqued shock bolts may damage or break the bolt if over-torqued and may vibrate loose if under-torqued. Under certain conditions during travel, the vehicle may experience excessive bouncing or swaying with decreased stability, leading to an increased risk of a vehicle crash.

***What we will do***

Keystone representatives have been in contact with the staff at your selling dealership regarding this situation. The remedy is to replace the existing shock bolts with a bolt replacement kit. The service and parts required for this corrective action will be provided at no charge to you.

***What we need you to do***

Limit the towing of the unit until this issue is resolved. As soon as possible, please make an appointment to have your RV serviced by your dealership. The labor time to perform this correction is approximately 1 hour. Please ask your dealer if you wish to know how much additional time will be needed to schedule and process your RV for this repair.

***If you have questions***

Your dealer is best equipped to obtain parts and provide service to ensure your RV is corrected as promptly as possible. Please contact Keystone Customer Service if your dealer is unable to assist or if you take your RV to your dealer on the agreed service date, and the dealer does not remedy the condition within a reasonable amount of time, or without charge to you. If you are unable to move your RV, please contact Keystone Customer Service for mobile service if your dealer doesn't have mobile capability. You may be eligible to receive reimbursement if you paid to have the defect resolved prior to receiving this correspondence. Keystone Customer Service is available toll-free at 1-866-425-4369.

***Parts enclosed***

For your convenience, the parts for this repair are enclosed. Please bring these parts to your service center when you arrive for your appointment. Please contact us for any assistance needed to complete this remedy.
