IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

NHTSA Recall # 26V-323

This notice applies to your vehicle(s), (see attached VIN listing)

Dear Valued Wabash Customer,

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Wabash National Corporation (Wabash) has decided that certain model year (MY) 2019 to 2023 Transcraft Platform Trailers and MY 2024 to 2027 Wabash Platform Trailers fail to conform to S8.2.3 of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 108, *"Lamps, reflective devices, and associated equipment."*

Description of Noncompliance:

The subject trailers may not be equipped with conspicuity tape that identifies the rear deck height as required in FMVSS 108 S8.2.3.

Risk to Motor Vehicle Safety:

Trailers without the required conspicuity tape may reduce the trailer's visibility to nearby drivers, potentially increasing the risk of a crash.

Remedy:

We are pleased to inform you that a remedy is available now! Enclosed with this notification is Wabash Technical Bulletin B-26017, which includes instructions to identify where and how to install conspicuity tape on the rear sill of your trailer(s). The equipment listed within should be remedied per the instructions described in B-26017 as soon as practical. This repair should take approximately 0.2 hours and will be performed at no cost to the owner. The owner may perform this recall and be reimbursed by Wabash, or you may contact your nearest Wabash Warranty Provider to schedule the repair. To order the remedy kit with the needed conspicuity tape, contact the Wabash Warranty Department at 800-247-2548, Monday – Friday, 7:00am – 4:00pm, ET.

If Already Remedied:

If this repair has been performed at cost to the owner prior to receipt of this notification, the owner may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.
