IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL 26507

This notice applies to your vehicle identified on the enclosed card.

Dear IC Bus Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

IC Bus has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2026 thru 2027 IC Bus™ Electric CE Series school buses built 10/08/2025 thru 04/08/2026.

REASON FOR THIS safety RECALL

The bolts that fasten the mounting bracket to the drive motor may not have been torqued to specification.

Risk to Motor vehicle safety

Bolts that are not torqued to specification may loosen over time, potentially allowing the drive motor to separate from its mounting bracket, which could increase the risk of a crash or injury.

DEFECT REMEDY

The remedy will involve torquing the drive mounting bolts to specification and replacing missing bolts, if necessary. The repair will be performed free of charge and take approximately 1 hour to complete.

ACTIONS YOU SHOULD TAKE

If you own this vehicle, please schedule an appointment with any IC Bus dealer to have your vehicle repaired. You can find your nearest dealer by using the dealer locator at <http://www.icbus.com> or by calling 1-800-448-7825.

If you have already paid for repairs prior to this notice that corrected the defect, you may be eligible for reimbursement of certain repair expenses if they occurred 10/08/2025 thru 06/30/2026. Present your original repair paperwork and proof of payment to any IC Bus dealer and your eligibility will be reviewed. You may also submit a claim using the enclosed Request for Reimbursement card.

If you are the lessor of this vehicle, please forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days to comply with federal regulations.

If you do not own this vehicle, please fill out and return mail the enclosed card so that you will not be contacted again about this recall.

IF YOU NEED ASSISTANCE

If you believe that IC Bus has failed to remedy the defect without charge or within a reasonable time, please follow the procedure described in the Owner Assistance Guide section in your Owner's Manual or call toll free 1-800-448-7825.
