

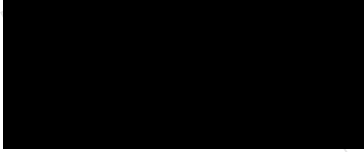

IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

NHTSA Recall No. 26V381

This notice applies to your vehicle, VIN Start with: 

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Dear Denago EV Owner:

Denago EV Corporation has decided that certain 2024–2026 Rover XL, Rover XL6, Rover XXL, and Nomad XL; 2024–2025 Nomad; and 2026 Scout 2 and Scout 4 low-speed vehicles fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 141, “Minimum Sound Requirements for Hybrid and Electric Vehicles.” Our records indicate that you own the vehicle identified above.

What is wrong. Your vehicle was built without an acoustic vehicle alerting system — the device that produces the exterior pedestrian alert sound that Standard No. 141 requires during low-speed operation. Your vehicle may therefore emit no such sound.

What is the risk. Pedestrians, cyclists, and others outside the vehicle may be less able to detect your vehicle as it approaches or moves at low speed, increasing the risk of a crash or of injury to them. You will receive no warning that the condition is present, and there are no precautions you can take to prevent it.

What we will do. Denago EV will correct this noncompliance by repair, without charge to you. An acoustic vehicle alerting system kit — consisting of an exterior sound generator/speaker and its mounting hardware — is being distributed through authorized Denago EV dealers. What you should do. Contact your authorized Denago EV dealer to obtain your kit, and bring this letter with you. If you do not know your nearest dealer, or need assistance with the remedy, call 1-737-732-2550 or write recall@denagoev.com.

If you no longer own this vehicle, please call 1-737-732-2550 so we can update our records. If you are the lessor of this vehicle, federal law requires that you forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.

If you believe Denago EV Corporation has failed or is unable to remedy the noncompliance without charge, or to do so within a reasonable time, you may submit a complaint to the Administrator, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 1200 New Jersey Avenue SE, Washington, DC 20590; call the toll-free Vehicle Safety Hotline at 1-888-327-4236 (TTY 1-800-424-9153); or go to www.nhtsa.gov. A reasonable time for repair is no longer than 60 days after you first tender your vehicle for repair on or after July 15, 2026, the date the remedy became available.

Reimbursement. If you paid to have an acoustic vehicle alerting system installed on your vehicle before receiving this notice, you may be eligible for reimbursement. Call 1-737-732-2550 or write to Denago EV Corporation, Recall Reimbursement, 3900 W Plano Parkway, Plano, TX 75075.
