Recreational Vehicle Safety Recall Notice

Dear *Customer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Newell Coach has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists on Newell Model P50 coaches, with coach numbers from 1800 through 1850. As a result, Newell Coach is conducting a safety recall. We apologize for any inconvenience this action may cause you; however your safety and satisfaction are of the utmost importance to us.

Reason for this recall

There is a defect with the steer axel air springs base material. This can cause the base to deform and crack during vehicle operation, potentially causing sudden loss of air pressure and suspension support which could lead to an accident, serious injury, or death.

What we will do

We will rectify the issue to ensure compliance with inspection of air springs and adding a 5/16" steel plate to reinforce the base, free of charge. This will consist of performing a visual inspection of the air spring base to check for deformation. If no deformation exists, the steel plate will be installed. If deformation is present, a new air spring bag with the steel plate will be installed. We estimate that this work will take approximately 2-4 hours depending on whether your vehicle needs a new air spring bag or not. However, depending on the work schedule at the service center, it may be necessary to keep your coach for a longer period of time.

What we need you to do

You should contact your Newell service advisor to schedule an appointment at the service center in Miami, OK or to make arrangements for a qualified service center in the field convenient to your location. For repairs made in the field, Newell will supply the necessary parts and pay the service center or reimburse you for the installation costs. If you have questions concerning this recall or if you need any assistance, please contact the Newell Coach Warranty/Service Department by mail at 3900 North Main Street, Miami, OK 74354, or by phone at 1-888-363-9355. If you had appropriate repairs related to this issue that were completed prior to receipt of this recall notice, and if you incurred any direct cost in connection with obtaining such repair, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement from Newell Coach by contacting the Newell Coach Warranty/Service Department.

If after contacting Newell Coach Customer Service, you are still not satisfied we have done our best to remedy this situation without charge and within a reasonable time, you may also submit a written complaint to: Administrator, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 1200 New Jersey Avenue, SE, Washington, DC 20590. You may call the toll-free Vehicle Safety Hotline at 1-888-327-4236 (TTY: 1-800-275-9171; or go to <http://www.safercar.gov>.) Federal regulations require that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.

Again, we apologize for any inconvenience this action may cause you. Your safety and satisfaction are our highest priority.
