Subject: NHTSA Safety Recall 26V-052Transport Canada Recall 2026-035 Winnebago of Indiana 44448204

Issue: Winnebago Towables has decided that a defect related to vehicle safety exists on certain 2026 Winnebago Access. These vehicles were manufactured **August 29th, 2025** through **October 31st, 2025**. There is a non-compliance with the Fed Tags missing the GAWR.

Dealers that have stock units impacted by this recall can access the full list of affected VINs sold to their dealership by accessing the Winnebago Dealer Portal.

Repair Information: The repair will consist of installing an updated VIN tag showing the correct GAWR. Repair instructions will be posted to the Winnebago Dealer Portal by the end of March.

Owner Notification: Winnebago Towables is mailing a customer letter notifying owners mid-March.

Dealer Responsibility Do not deliver any subject trailer until corrective action has been taken. All vehicles subject to this campaign are to be serviced at no charge to the owners regardless of mileage, age of vehicle, or ownership from this time forward.

Notes **Important Reminder:** It is a violation of federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification until the noncompliance is remedied.

Dear Winnebago Owner:

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Our records indicate that you have purchased a vehicle with the serial number which appears above.

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

Winnebago Towable (Winnebago) is recalling certain 2026 Access travel trailers. The Gross Axle Weight Rating (GAWR) may not be listed on the certification label. As such, these vehicles fail to comply with the requirements of 49 CFR Part 567, "Certification."

Missing weight information may lead to unintentionally overloading the vehicle, increasing the risk of a crash.

WHAT WE WILL DO

On affected vehicles, Winnebago of Indiana will replace the Vehicle Certification Label and the Tire and Loading Information label with a new corrected label and installation instructions. The customers will also have the option to utilize a dealer for installation. The time necessary to complete the repair will be approximately 20 minutes. Please allow additional time for the dealer to process your vehicle. **This repair will be done at no charge to you.**

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

After the new labels are installed, please send a photo for confirmation of installation and to complete the recall on your unit.

- Blow dryer or heat gun

Repair Instructions

Step 1: Remove incorrect VIN Tag on the off door side of the unit using a heat gun or blow dryer

Step 2: Clean area and wipe dry. Apply new VIN Tag to the compartment door.
