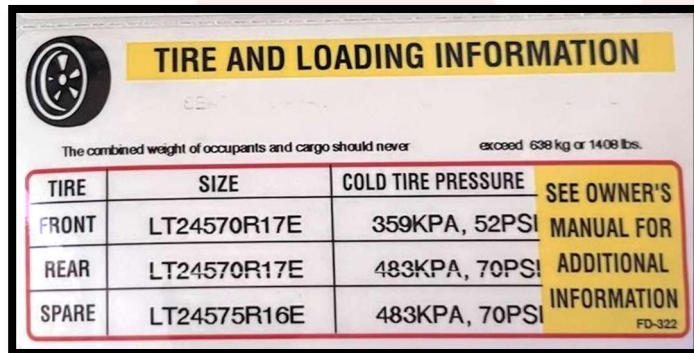

Steps & Procedures

1. Locate the Tire and Loading Information inside of the driver's side door jamb, on the forward face of the B-Pillar.
2. Remove and discard existing Tire and Loading Information Label, this will reveal the OEM chassis manufacturer's Tire Inflation Pressure Label.
3. Clean the face of the OEM Label with Isopropyl alcohol and ensure it is dry. Then cover the OEM Tire Inflation Pressure Label with the new Tire and Loading Information Label.
