Safety Recall: 2016–21 Civic Seat Weight Sensor

BACKGROUND

Affected vehicles may be equipped with seat weight sensors that are not built to proper specifications. Improperly built sensors could lead to cracking and/or a short circuit of the sensor, resulting in the illumination of the SRS warning light and the passenger airbag indicator remaining OFF. In certain collisions, these seat weight sensors may cause improper deployment of the front passenger airbags, increasing the risk of injury.

CUSTOMER NOTIFICATION

Owners of affected vehicles will be sent a notification of this safety recall.

Do an iN VIN status inquiry to verify eligibility.

Some vehicles affected by this campaign may be in your new or used vehicle inventory.

Failure to repair a vehicle subject to a recall or campaign may subject your dealership to claims or lawsuits from the customer or anyone else harmed as a result of such failure. To see if a vehicle in inventory is affected by this safety recall, do a VIN status inquiry before selling it.

CORRECTIVE ACTION

Replace the seat weight sensors.

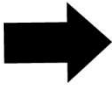

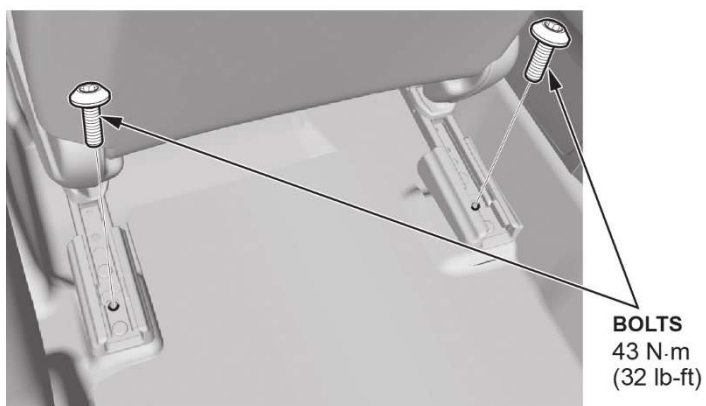

1. Remove the label from the new seat weight sensor box and affix it to the repair order.

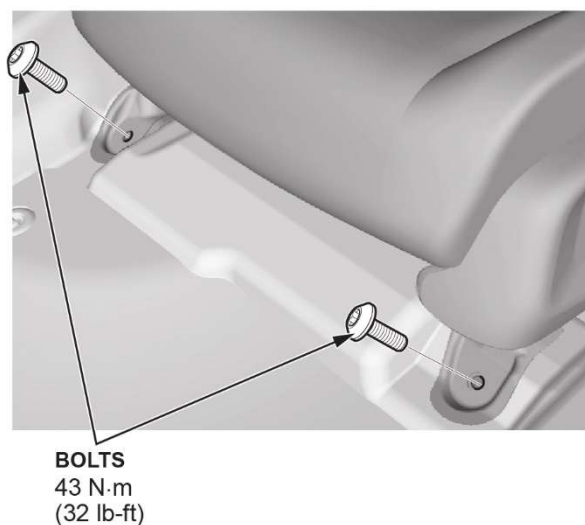
- Slide the passenger's seat all the way forward and remove the rear seat rail fasteners.

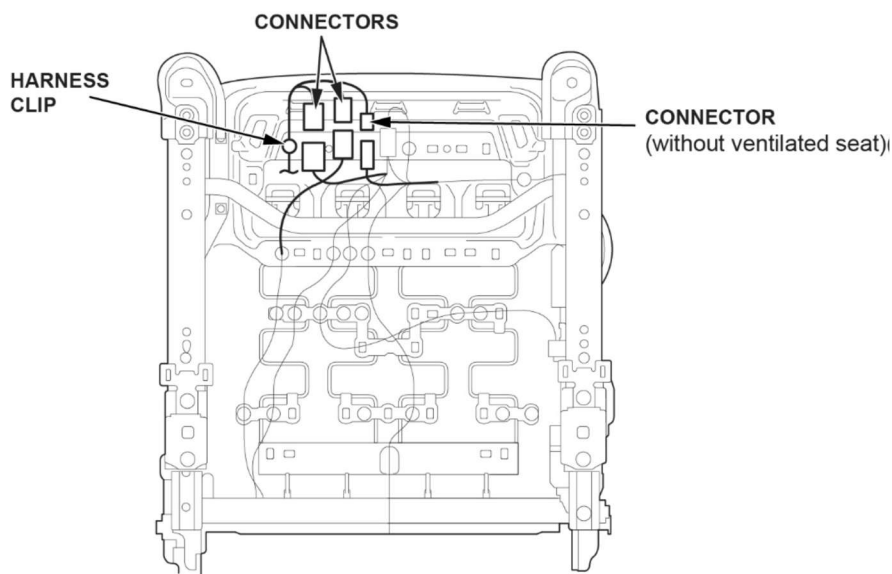


- Slide the passenger's seat all the way rearward and remove the front rail fasteners.

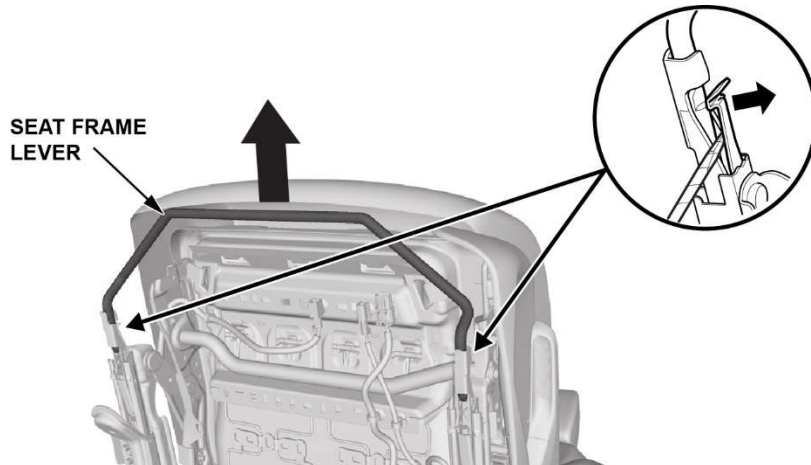

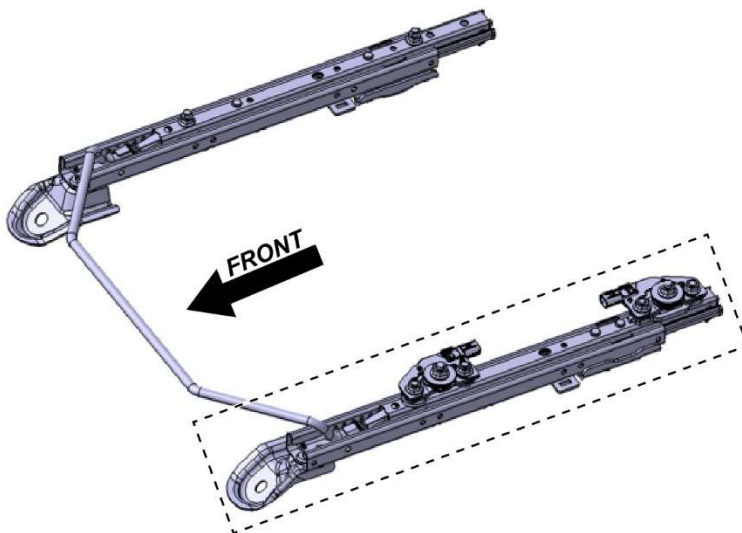
- Disconnect the negative cable to the 12-volt battery.

 - Lift the front seat, then disconnect the connectors and detach the harness clip.
- NOTE: Take a picture of the harness routing prior to removal for future reference.



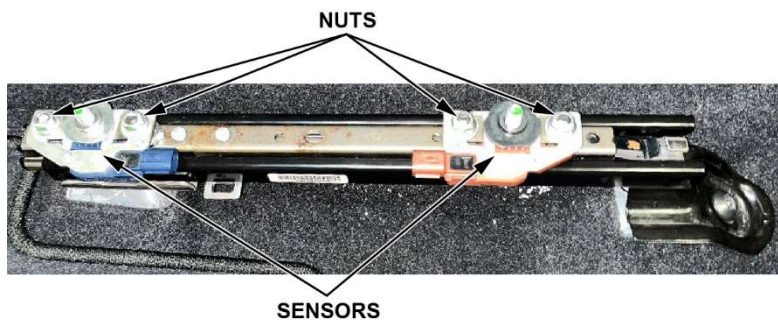
6. With the help of an assistant, carefully remove the front seat through the front door opening. Then, place the seat on a suitable work area.
7. Remove the seat frame lever.



8. Remove the inner seat rail (with sensors) from the seat.



9. Mount the inner seat rail into the vehicle and remove the 2 seat weight sensors, then discard the nuts and sensors.



10. Install the new sensors and nuts in the orientation shown.

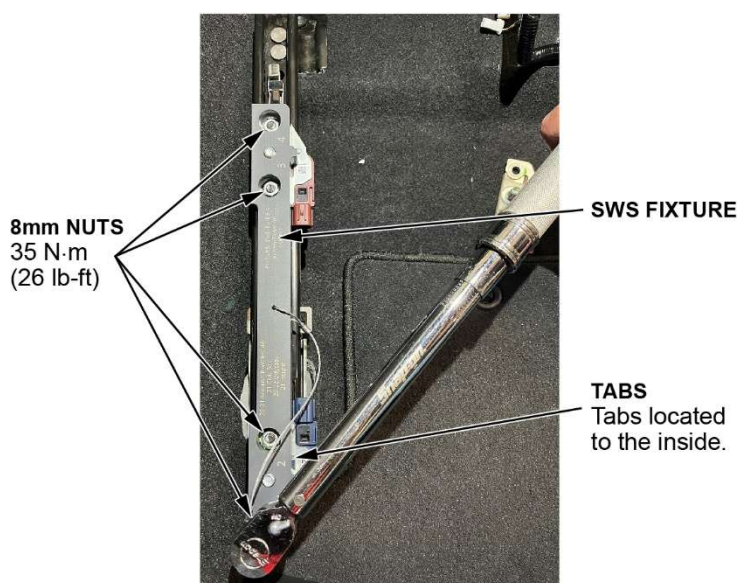
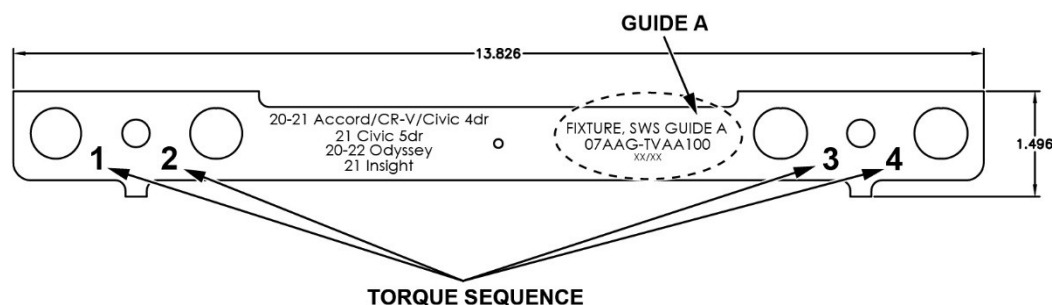


**SENSOR POSITION 2

11. Place the **SWS Fixture Guide A** onto the new seat weight sensors with the tabs located to the inside of the seat track. With the guide properly seated on the new sensors, **torque the nuts to 35 N·m (26 lb-ft) in the order shown on the SWS fixture guide.**

NOTE: Use the socket provided with the guide.

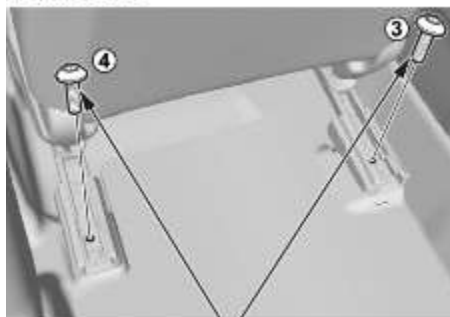


12. Remove the seat rail from the vehicle, then reinstall the seat rail to the seat frame. Use new washers and nuts and torque to **55 N·m (41 lb-ft)**.

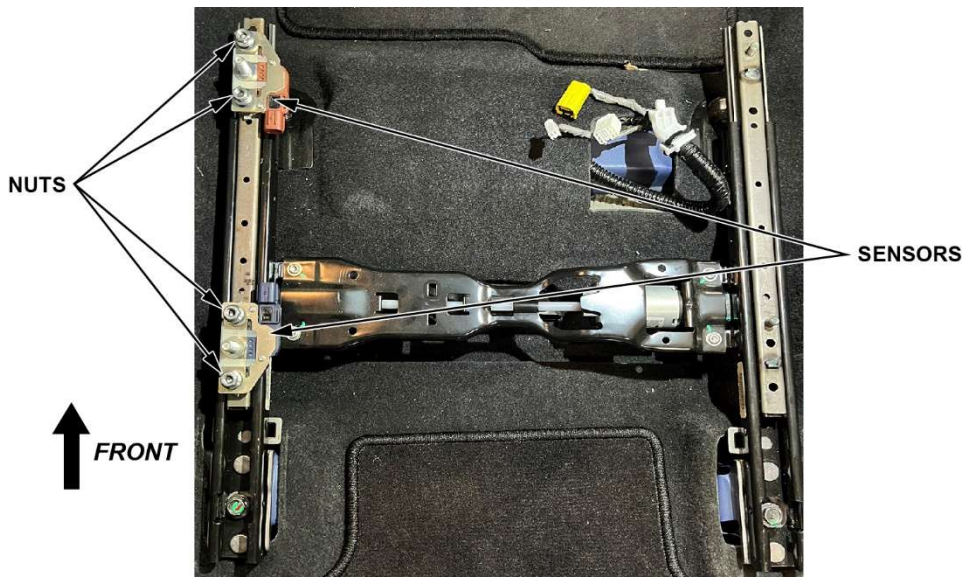
6. With the help of an assistant, carefully remove the passenger's front seat through the front door opening and place the seat on a suitable area to work.
7. Disconnect the connector to the power motor.

8. Remove the seat rails from the seat.

NOTE: Take a picture of all four seat frame nuts, bushings, and collars for reference.



9. Mount the seat rail into the vehicle and remove the 2 seat weight sensors, then discard the nuts and sensors.



10. Install the new sensors and nuts in the orientation shown.

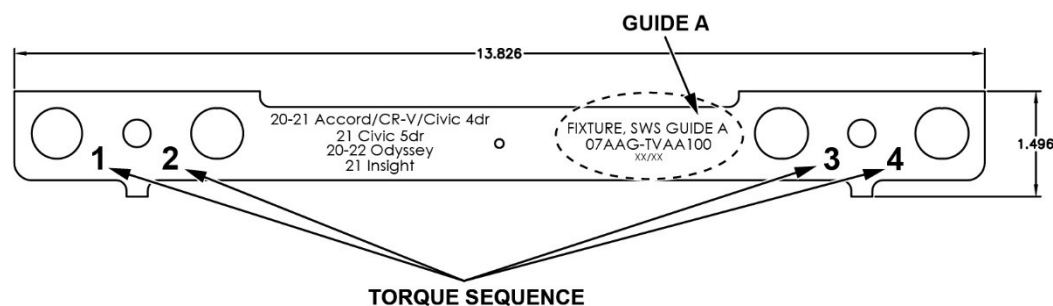

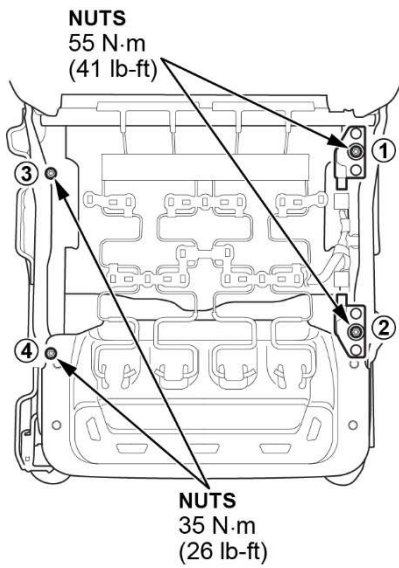

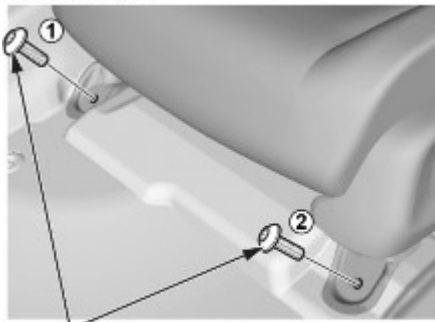


12. Remove the seat rail from the vehicle and reinstall the seat rail to the seat frame. Use new washers and nuts and torque the left side seat frame nuts to **55 N·m (40 lb-ft)**. The right-side nuts should be torqued to **35 N·m (26 lb-ft)**.



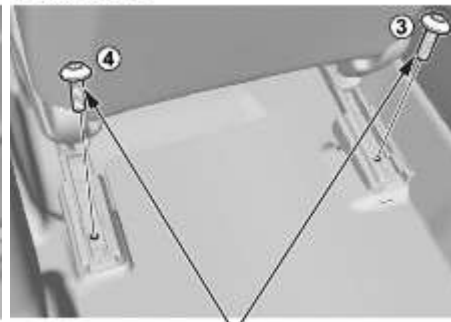
13. Install the passenger's seat into the car and tighten the bolts by hand, then torque them to **43 N·m (32 lb-ft)** in the sequence shown.

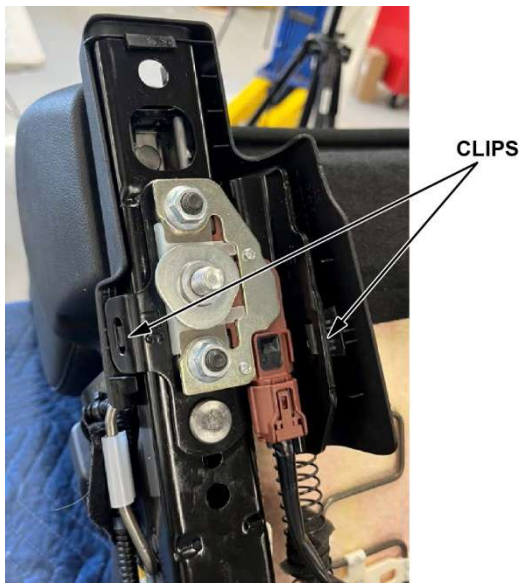
6. Carefully remove the passenger's seat from the vehicle and place it on a suitable work area.

8. Remove the left bracket and cross brace by removing the four bolts.



9. Remove the left rear rail cover.



10. Remove the seat weight sensors, then discard the sensors and nuts.



11. Install the new sensors and nuts in the orientation shown.

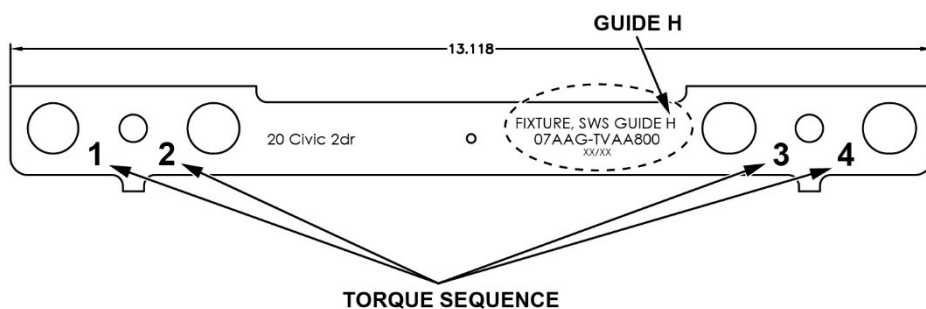


SENSOR POSITION 2

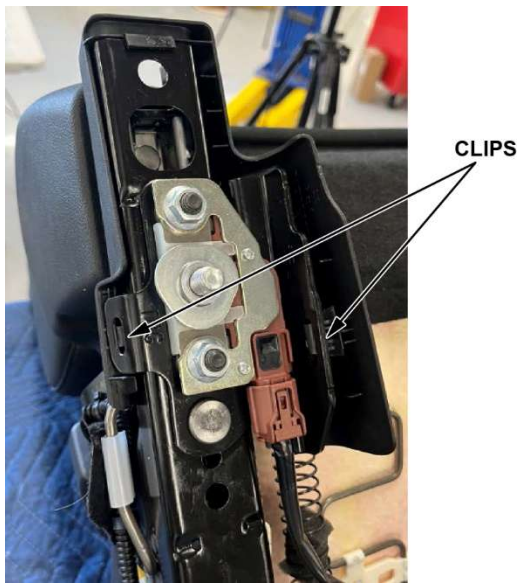

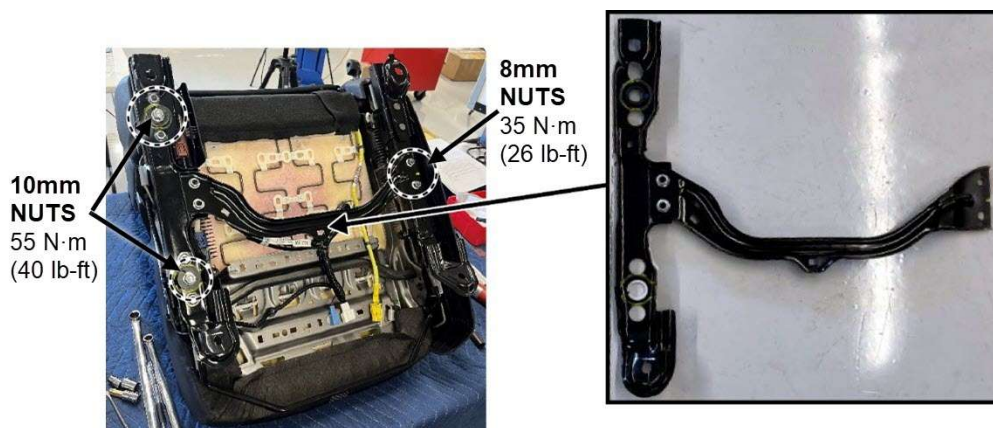

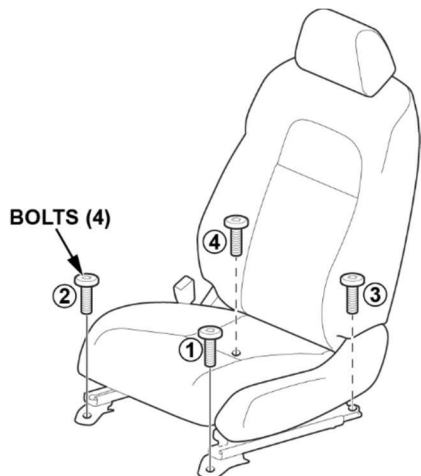
13. Install the left rear rail cover.

15. Install the seat and reconnect all connectors. Hand tighten the bolts first, then torque them in sequence **43 N·m (32 lb-ft)**.
