



**Safety Recall: NHTSA 26v-044
Interim Owner Notification
March 11, 2026**

Dear Grand Design RV Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Grand Design RV has determined that a safety defect exists in certain **2021-2024 Grand Design Momentum and Solitude Fifth Wheels built with Curt Axles**. Accordingly, a recall to address this issue is being initiated effective 3/11/2026.

Why is a recall being conducted?

Your RV may be equipped with Curt Axles, the u-bolts on these axles may loosen over time due to inadequate clamp load at the axle to spring interface. This recall supersedes recalls 23v-490 and 24v-193. If you have had one of these recalls performed, you will still require this recall remedy.

What are we doing about the problem?

Grand Design is continuing to prepare parts and remedy to your RV. These parts and remedy instructions are anticipated to be available by Q2 2026. **When final repair parts and instructions are available, Grand Design will send a second letter asking you to bring your RV to a Grand Design dealer for the repair, which will be free of charge for parts and labor.**

What should you do?

Prior to any trips taken before your remedy can be performed, your u-bolts and leaf springs should be visually inspected for uneven threads on the u-bolts and/or shifted axles or leaf springs. If you have visual indicators of a compromised suspension or you have already had a failure that has not been reported please contact your Grand Design dealer for diagnosis.

What if I no longer own this recreational vehicle?

If you have already paid to have your vehicle repaired for this condition, you may be eligible for reimbursement of the charges you paid for the repair. To request reimbursement, please submit your request in writing along with a repair receipt to: Grand Design RV, Customer Service, 11356 County Road 2, Middlebury, IN 46540.

If after having attempted to take advantage of this recall you believe you have not been able to have your vehicle remedied without charge and within a reasonable amount of time, you may submit a complaint to the Administrator, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 1200 New Jersey Ave., S.E., Washington, D.C., 20590; or call the toll-free Vehicle Safety Hotline at 1-888-327-4236 (TTY: 1-800-424-9153); or go to <http://www.safercar.gov>.
