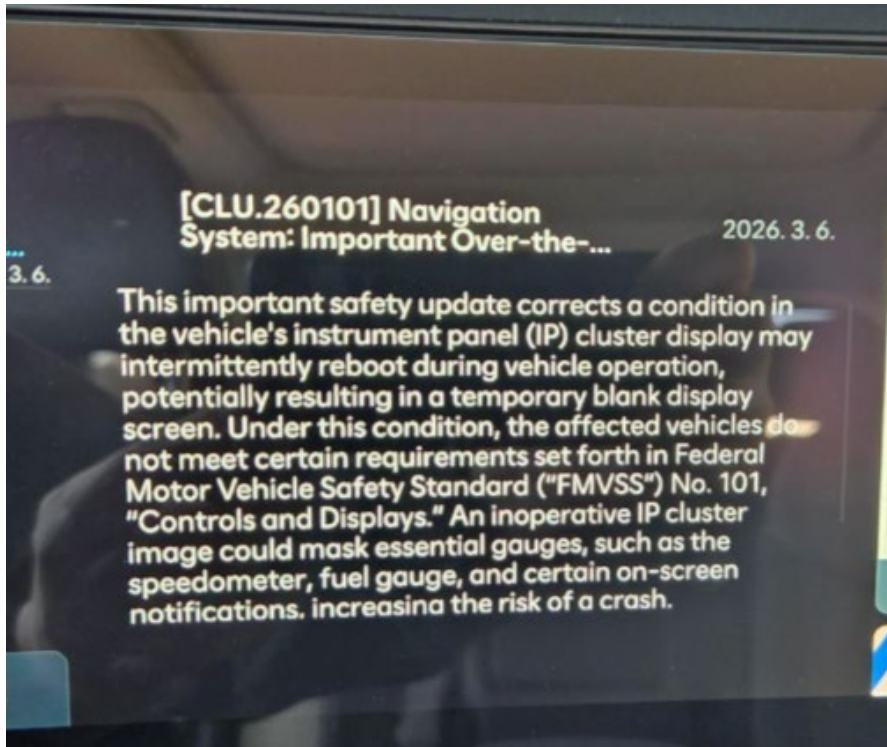




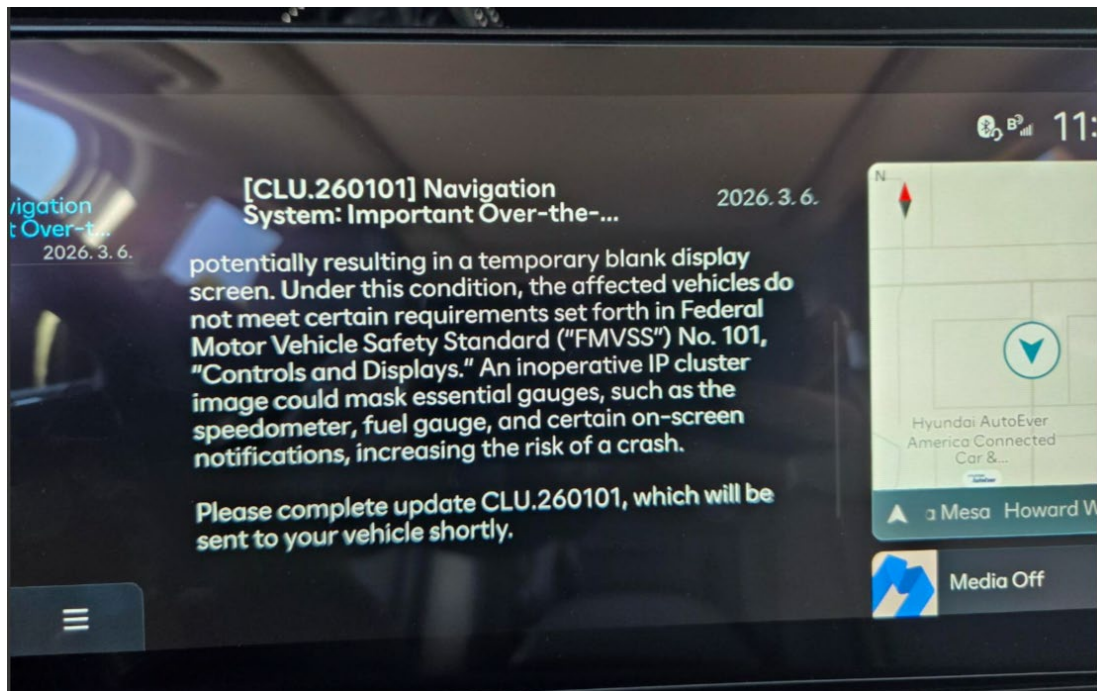
Hyundai Recall 293 (NHTSA Recall # 26V-047)

Infotainment Messaging for Over-The-Air Update

- The following notification is sent to all impacted customers prior to the release of the OTA remedy.



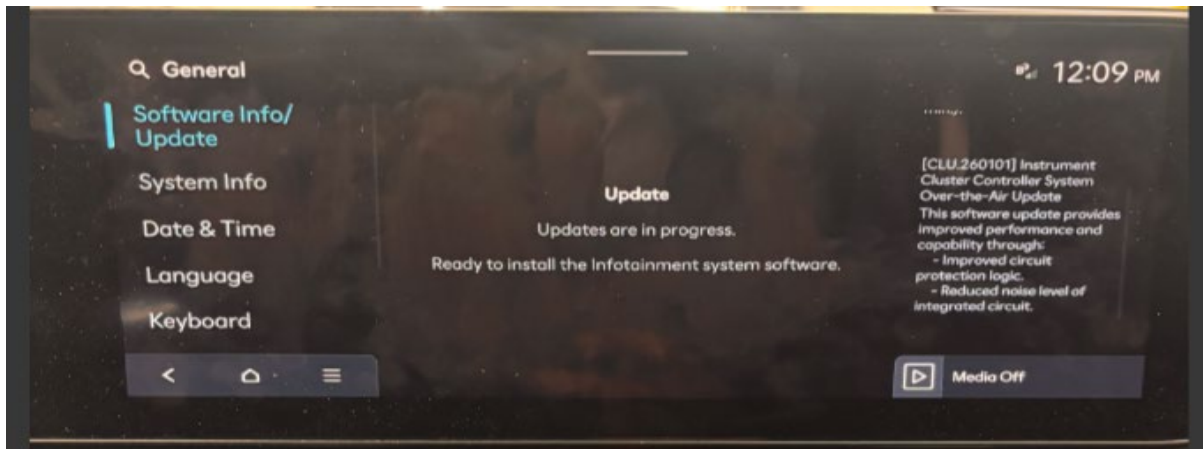
This important safety update corrects a condition in the vehicle's instrument panel (IP) cluster display may intermittently reboot during vehicle operation, potentially resulting in a temporary blank display screen. Under this condition, the affected vehicles do not meet certain requirements set forth in Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard ("FMVSS") No. 101, "Controls and Displays." An inoperative IP cluster image could mask essential gauges, such as the speedometer, fuel gauge, and certain on-screen notifications, increasing the risk of a crash.



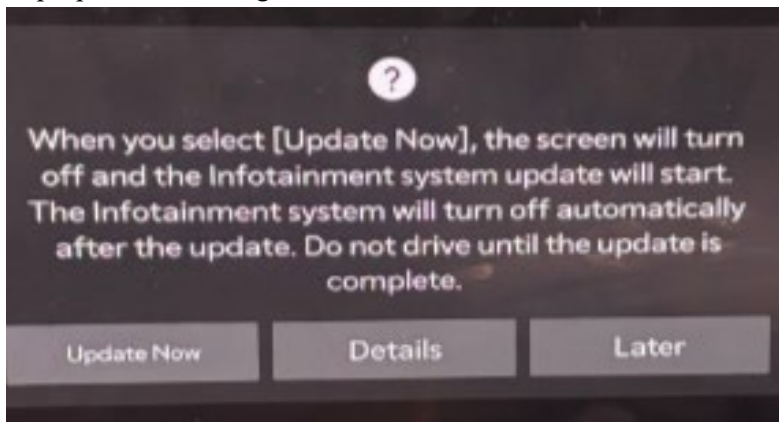


Once the over-the-air (OTA) software has been downloaded and the background update is finished, the software update will be available to install.

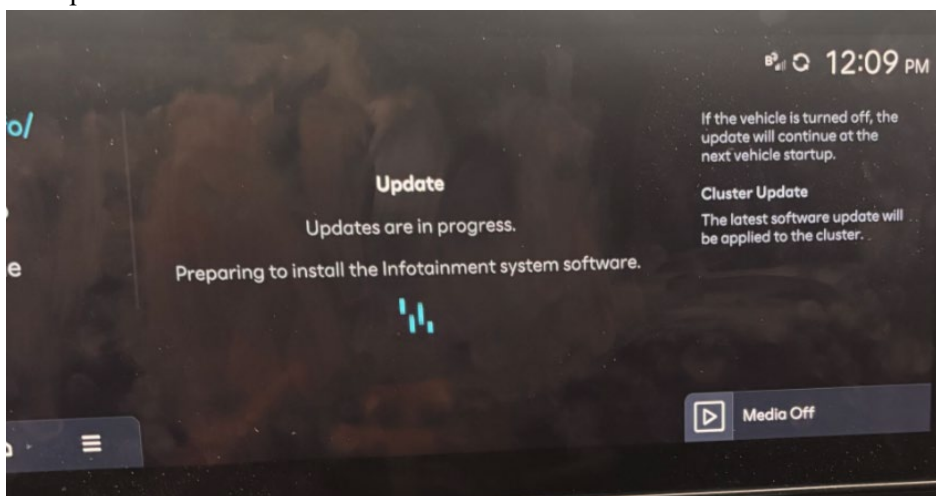

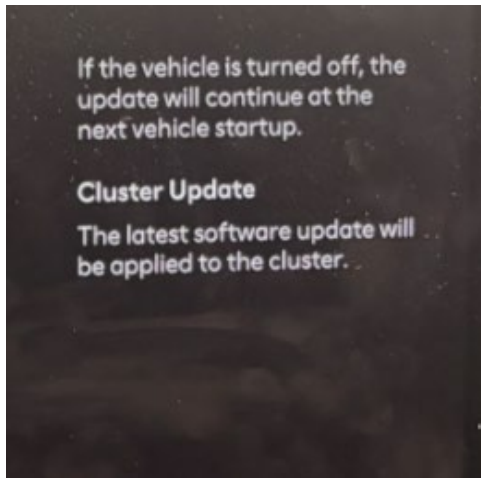


- Pop-up Screen after Ignition is turned off:

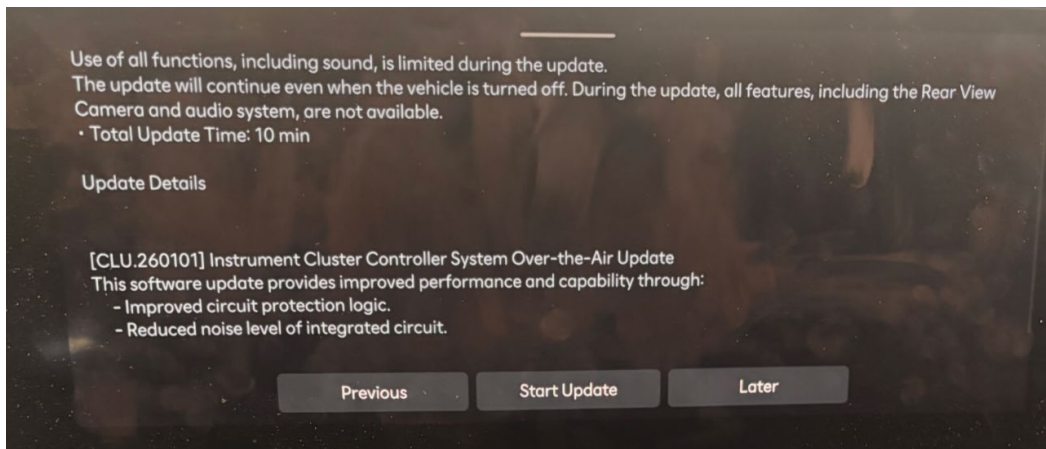


- Pre-update What's New Details:

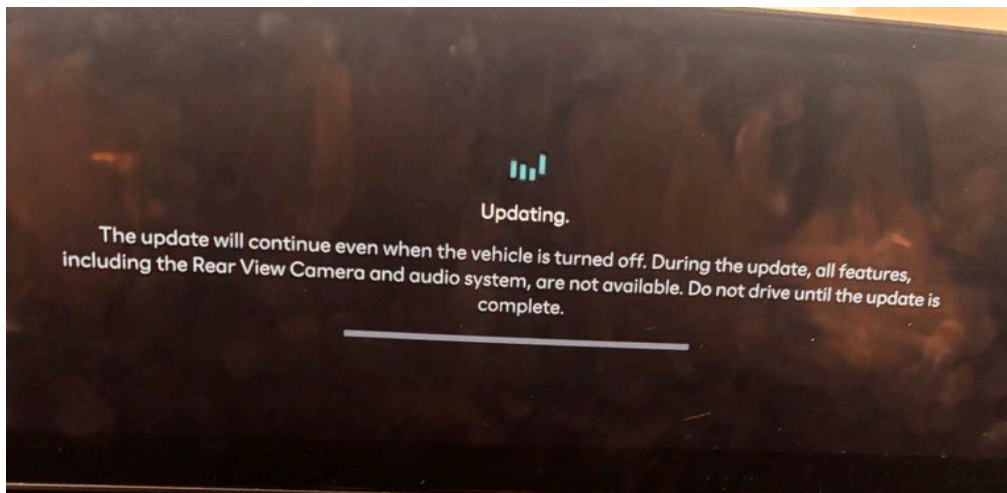




- Update Pop-up Details Screen:



- 1st Screen after Start Update/Update Now selection:

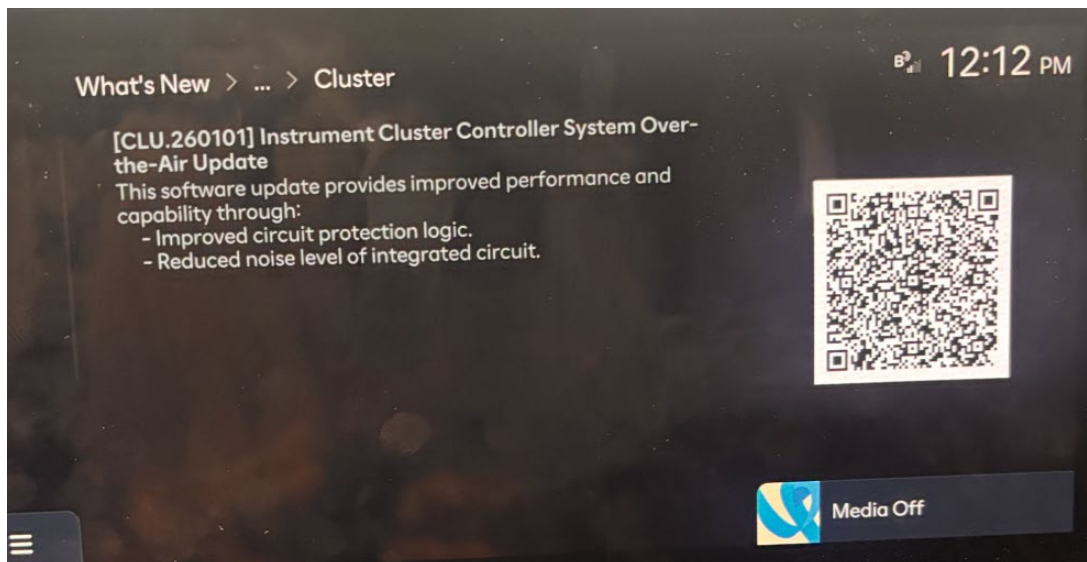




- What's New & QR Code Pop-Up Screen text after the update:
