Issue: Ferrari has detected an issue regarding the installation of black rear and side windows on certain units of the Ferrari 12Cilindri model, including the Affected 12Cilindri Vehicles, which were manufactured for the US market. The issue was caused by a wrong configuration of the model technical features for the US market. Automobile glazing with less than 70% light transmittance can impair the driver’s visibility and lead to a crash. Ferrari decided to launch a recall campaign to remedy this potential issue and has notified NHTSA.

Ferrari shall replace, as a remedy solution, the black rear and side windows with windows compliant with FMVSS No. 205.

Required Dealer Action:

- Effective immediately and until further notice, ALL of the Affected 12Cilindri Vehicles are on mandatory stop-sale hold.
- DO NOT sell, offer for sale or lease, or allow demo/test drives of any of the Affected 12Cilindri Vehicles.
- In the interest of customer safety and satisfaction, place all of the Affected 12Cilindri Vehicles at your dealership in a secure area where they cannot be made available for sale, lease, trade or demonstrator use until a repair to address this issue has been performed.

IMPORTANT REMINDER: VEHICLES AFFECTED BY SAFETY & COMPLIANCE RECALLS

New Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: It is a violation of federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. By law, dealers must correct, prior to delivery for sale or lease, any vehicle that fails to comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or that contains a defect relating to motor vehicle safety.

Pre-Owned Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: Dealers should not deliver any pre-owned vehicles in their inventory which are involved in a safety or compliance recall until the defect has been remedied.
