Nissan has decided that your 2008 Pathfinder V-8 was manufactured with an incorrect underhood Vehicle Emission Control Information (VECI) label. The label contains an incorrect letter in the emission test group code.

## Reason for Recall

The VECI label contains the code that tells a testing facility which test to perform to ensure the vehicle is tested to the correct standard. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and California Air Resources Board consider the underhood VECI label an integral part of state emission testing. If the label is incorrect, your vehicle may subsequently fail that test even if it meets applicable emissions standards.

# What Nissan Will Do

Provided with this notification is a replacement VECI label with the correct emission test group. Also included (on the reverse side of this letter) are instructions for the installation of your replacement VECI label.

#### What You Should Do.

Please replace the VECI label on your vehicle with the one included with this notice. Installation instructions are provided on the reverse side of this letter. The actual time to replace the label is approximately 10 minutes. If you prefer, contact your Nissan dealer and make an appointment to have the new label installed at **no charge** to you. Please bring this notice and replacement label with you to the service appointment.
