## Dear Audi Owner:

As part of Audi's commitment to our environment, we would like to inform you of our decision to extend your Emissions Control Systems Warranty for the engine coolant temperature (ECT) sensor to 10 years or 100,000 miles (160,000 km), whichever occurs first, from the vehicle's original in-service date. The vehicle's original in-service date is defined as the date the vehicle was delivered to either the original purchaser or the original lessee; or if the vehicle was first placed in service as a "demonstrator" or "company" car, on the date such vehicle was first placed in service.

The ECT sensor is an important emission control device on your vehicle, which, in the event it malfunctions, may cause the Malfunction Indicator Lamp (MIL) on your instrument panel to illuminate and could also cause your engine's coolant temperature gauge to read incorrectly. Vehicles with a faulty ECT sensor may exceed Federal and/or California emissions standards and possibly fail a smog check program, and your vehicle registration application could be denied. This warranty extension only covers diagnosis and replacement of the ECT sensor. For additional information concerning your Emissions Control Systems Warranty, please consult your Warranty Booklet or your authorized Audi dealer.

If the ECT sensor on your vehicle malfunctions, your authorized Audi dealer will replace it without charge, as long as the vehicle remains within the above time and mileage limits. Although your authorized Audi dealer does not require you to produce this letter to receive the benefits of this extended warranty, Audi suggests you retain this letter as proof of eligibility for this warranty extension. Please keep this letter with your Warranty Booklet and deliver it to any subsequent owner along with the Owner Manual.

If you have previously paid for replacement of an ECT sensor, the enclosed form explains how to request reimbursement.

We are pleased to offer this extended emissions warranty and trust that you will continue to be a member of the exclusive Audi family. Thank you for your continued loyalty.
