

OWNER'S LETTER

Dear Nissan Altima owner:

Nissan is committed to providing the highest levels of product quality and customer satisfaction. Nissan has decided that your 2011 2.5L Altima was manufactured with an incorrect underhood Vehicle Emission Control Information (VECI) label. The label does not clearly define the emission standard to which the vehicle was certified.

Reason for Recall

The VECI label provides information in order for the vehicle to meet applicable emission standards. These labels are used to ensure correct vehicle emission testing by identifying the vehicle's emission control system. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and California Air Resources Board consider the underhood VECI label an integral part of state emission testing. Because the label is incorrect, your vehicle will be subjected to an incorrect emission test and subsequently fail that test.

What Nissan Will Do

Provided with this notification is a replacement VECI label with the correct emission standard. Also included are instructions for the installation of your replacement VECI label.

What You Should Do

Please replace the VECI label on your vehicle with the one included with this notice. Installation instructions are provided. The actual time to replace the label is approximately 10 minutes. If you prefer, contact your Nissan dealer and make an appointment to have the new label installed at **no charge** to you. Please bring this notice and replacement label with you to the service appointment. If the dealer fails, or is unable to make the necessary repairs free of charge, you may contact the National Consumer Affairs Department, Nissan North America, Inc., P.O.
