- 1. Update the PGM-FI software. Refer to Service Bulletin 01-026, *Updating Control Units/Modules*.
- 2. Center-punch a completion mark above the first character of the engine compartment VIN:

3. For California Residents Only: Fill out a Vehicle Emissions Recall - Proof of Correction certificate, and use R91 as the recall number. Give the certificate to your client, and advise him or her to keep it as proof that the product update was completed. Your client will need to submit the certificate to the DMV only if the DMV requests it. If you need more certificates, use reorder number Y0657.

This work will be done free of charge. Please plan to leave your vehicle at the dealer for half a day to allow them flexibility in scheduling.

California Residents - After doing the update, your dealer will give you a Proof of Correction certificate. Keep this certificate for your records as proof that the product update was completed. Submit the certificate to the DMV only if the DMV requests it.

What to do if you feel this notice is in error.

Our records show that you are the current owner or lessee of a 2007 MDX involved in this campaign. If this is not the case, or the name/address information is not correct, complete, sign, and return the enclosed, postage-paid Information Change Card. We will then update our records.

If you previously paid to have the rear warm-up three-way catalytic converter replaced, you may be eligible for reimbursement, even if you no longer own the vehicle. Refer to the attached Instructions for Reimbursement form for eligibility requirements and the reimbursement procedure.
