TITLE : Correct tire and loading information label
DOCUMENT # : 11 P 002
AFFECTED VEHICLES : 12C Coupe

SITUATION : Quality Engineering at McLaren Automotive have produced an amended tire and loading information label for vehicles in the federal market. The information regarding the rear wheel size on the existing labels is incorrect. The new label rectifies the situation.

PROCEDURE : It is necessary to replace the tire and loading information label on all affected vehicles to ensure the information is correct.

The label is located on the inner edge of the passenger door, as per the image below. It contains the following information:

- The maximum number of occupants (1) divided between the front (2) and rear (3) of the vehicle.
- The vehicle capacity weight (4), which includes the weight of the driver, passenger and cargo.
- The size of the tires (5) with which the vehicle was originally equipped.
- Cold inflation pressures for the front and rear tires (6).
- Details of the spare wheel (7), even though this will not be applicable for this model.



REMOVAL:

1. Open passenger door and peel off the Tire and Loading Information label, ensuring the remaining residue of the label is cleaned away.

INSTALLATION :

2. Attach a new tire and loading information label in exactly the same place as the previous label.
