3.3 Insert the guide pins  $\Rightarrow$  *Figure 4*-1- as far as they will go into the mountings  $\Rightarrow$  *Figure 4*-arrows- until the locking lugs on both sides lock with an audible click.

3.4 Check that you can swivel the screen. Place your thumbs on the outer part of the chrome strip  $\Rightarrow$  *Figure 5* - **arrow A**- and press the screen inwards. Then swivel the screen back by pressing  $\Rightarrow$  *Figure 5* - **arrow B**-. Loosen the display unit if necessary and check the line routing. See Step 2 (Remove display unit).



i Information

The software in the new display unit is either V02.000 or V02.009. The previous software version was V01.xxx. A USB stick is enclosed with the new display

unit. The USB stick is used to update V01.xxx of the software of the other display unit to version V02.000.

It is not possible to update software versions V01.xxx and V02.000 to software version V02.009.

- 4 Check the software version of both display units.
  - 4.1 Switch on the display units. To do this, press the **ON/OFF** button on both display units for about 2 seconds. PRSE is ready for operation after about 5 seconds.
  - 4.2 Press the **Option** button on both display units.
  - 4.3 Press the **System info** button on both display units.
  - 4.4 Is software version V02.000 or V02.009 displayed?

- 5 Update software version V01.xxx of the display unit to software version V02.000.
  - 5.1 Switch off the display units. To do this, press and hold the **ON/OFF** button for about 2 seconds.
  - 5.2 Insert the USB stick in the USB port of the display unit running software version V01.xxx.
  - 5.3 Switch on the display unit. To do this, press the **ON/OFF** button for about 2 seconds. PRSE is ready for operation after about 5 seconds.
  - 5.4 The software update is automatically started. The display unit switches off after the software update is complete.
  - 5.5 Remove the USB stick from the USB jack on the display unit.
- 6 Adjust the basic setting of the new display unit.
  - 6.1 Switch on the display unit. To do this, press the **ON/OFF** button for about 2 seconds. PRSE is ready for operation after about 5 seconds.
  - 6.2 Press the **OPTION** button.

7.1.2 Insert a CD/DVD  $\Rightarrow$  Figure 26 -9so that the printed side is facing you. Once the DVD/CD is inserted fully, swivel the display unit  $\Rightarrow$ Figure 25 -B- back. The CD/DVD starts playing. Press the Menu button on the console if necessary and select SOURCE, then **DISK**.

7.1.3 Check transmission/reception function **CROSSLINK**. Select **CROSSLINK** in the SOURCE menu on the second display unit.

7.1.4 **Only** for vehicles with TV tuner: Check TV signal on the display unit.

Select TV in the SOURCE menu.

- 7.2 Check transmission/reception function **CROSSLINK** on a display unit that has **not** been changed (replaced); to do this perform Steps 7.1.1 to 7.1.3.
- 7.3 Switch off the display units. To do this, press and hold the **ON/OFF** button for about 2 seconds.
- 7.4 Take off the headphones and switch them off.

7.5 Fold the outer ear cups into each other and stow the headphones away.
