

**Front Brake Noise**

This bulletin replaces bulletin Group 4, #1104, dated 7-15-11.

Vehicle Type: **Cayenne S & S Hybrid**

Model Year: **2011**

Information: New rotors and pads are available to help reduce noise complaints on front brakes.

Work Procedure: 2011 Cayennes produced **before** November 1, 2010 may exhibit front brake noise that is louder than normal. If this is the case, the front rotors and pads may be changed to reduce the noise. Vehicles produced **after** November 1, 2010 already have the new rotors and pads.

The front brakes must be diagnosed so that the source of the noise is isolated to the contact between the pads and rotors. Contact between other brake components that create noise does not warrant replacement of the rotors and pads.
