Information:	This is to inform you of a voluntary Workshop Campaign on the above-mentioned vehicles. There is the possibility that the wire harnesses in both exterior mirrors may not be routed correctly. As a result, the wire harnesses can become damaged when the exterior mirrors are folded in and the electric functions of the exterior mirrors can fail.						
Action Required:	<ul> <li>Check routing of wire harnesses in both exterior mirrors and secure wire harnesses to the mirror base by installing an additional cable holder. ⇒ Scope 1</li> <li>Check routing of wire harnesses in both exterior mirrors, secure wire harnesses to the mirror base by installing an additional cable holder and replace wire harnesses that are already damaged. ⇒ Scope 2 or 3</li> </ul>						
Affected Vehicles:	The VIN(s) can be checked by using PIWIS Vehicle Information link to verify if the campaign affects the vehicle. This Campaign is scope specific to the VIN! Failure to verify in PIWIS may result in an improper repair.						
Note:	NOT ALL VEHICLES WILL REQUIRE PARTS. VEHICLES MUST BE INSPECTED BEFORE PARTS CAN BE ORDERED. PLEASE FILE A PTEC FOR RELEASE OF REQUIRED PARTS AFTER A VEHICLE INSPECTION HAS BEEN COMPLETED. THERE WILL BE NO AUTOMATIC ALLOCATION OF PARTS.

### Attachment "A": Work Procedure

#### Checking and reworking routing of wire harnesses in both exterior mirrors



## Information

The procedure described here must be carried out on both exterior mirrors.

The figures show the work to be carried out on the **left** side of the vehicle in direction of travel. The work on the right side of the vehicle must be carried out in the same way.

- 1 Remove exterior mirror housing  $\Rightarrow$  Workshop Manual '667919 Removing and installing housing for rear-view mirror section on "Removing".
- 2 Check routing of wire harness for exterior mirrors and check for signs of chafing.



### Information

Figure 1 shows the correct routing of the wire harness at the exterior mirror. Figure 2 shows the incorrect routing of the wire harness.

2.1 If the wire harness for exterior mirrors  $\Rightarrow$ Figure 1 -item 1- as shown in  $\Rightarrow$  Figure 1 is in front of the locking disc  $\Rightarrow$  Figure 1 -item 2- on the mirror base  $\Rightarrow$  Figure 1 -arrow- $\Rightarrow$ the wire harness is routed correctly.  $\Rightarrow$  Continue with Step 4.2 and secure the wire harness by installing an additional cable holder.



- 2.2 If the wire harness for exterior mirrors ⇒ Figure 2-item 1- as shown in ⇒ Figure 2 is over the locking disc ⇒ Figure 2-item 2- on the mirror base ⇒ Figure 2-arrow-⇒ the wire harness is not routed correctly.
  ⇒ Continue with Step 2.2.1 and check the wire harness for signs of chafing.
  - 2.2.1 If the protective sleeve (fabric tape) on the wire harness is worn through⇒ continue with Step 3 and replace the wire harness.
  - 2.2.2 If the protective sleeve (fabric tape) on the wire harness is **not worn through⇒ continue** with **Step 4** and **route the wire harness correctly** and secure it by fitting an additional cable holder.



## Information

If the protective sleeve (fabric tape) on the wire harness is **chafed**  $\Rightarrow$  **wrap insulating tape** around the chafed area and then route the wire harness correctly.

### 3 Replacing wire harness

- 3.1 Remove wire harness for exterior mirrors  $\Rightarrow$  Workshop Manual '974319 Removing and installing wire harness for rear-view mirror section on "Installing".
- 3.2 **Install new** wire harness for exterior mirrors ⇒ Workshop Manual '974319 Removing and installing wire harness for rear-view mirror section on "Installing".
- 4 Retrofit additional cable holder for securing the wire harness.

4.1 Route the wire harness  $\Rightarrow$  Figure 3 -item 1- as shown in  $\Rightarrow$  Figure 3 so that it is routed in front of the locking disc  $\Rightarrow$  Figure 3 -item 2- on the mirror base.



- 4.2 Install an additional cable holder  $\Rightarrow$  Figure 4 -item 2- as shown in  $\Rightarrow$  Figure 4 on the mirror base  $\Rightarrow$  Figure 4 -item 3- and use it to secure the wire harness  $\Rightarrow$  Figure 4 -item 1-.
- 5 Install exterior mirror housing  $\Rightarrow$  Workshop Manual '667919 Removing and installing housing for rear-view mirror - section on "Installing".
- 6 Complete steps 1 to 5 on the other exterior mirror.
- 7 Enter the workshop campaign in the Warranty and Maintenance booklet.


