Subject: Click Clunk Pop Type Noise From Front When Turning

Models: 2008 - 2013 Chevrolet Express

2008 - 2013 GMC Savana

This PI was superseded to update model years. Please discard PIT5054.

The following diagnosis might be helpful if the vehicle exhibits the symptom(s) described in this PI.

Condition/Concern

Some owners may comment of a click, clunk, pop type noise coming from the front end. This noise is most noticeable while turning left or right at slow speeds up/down an incline.

This noise may be caused by the front bumper cover contacting the fender, as shown below:



- 1. Left Front Park/Turn Lamp
- 2. Grill
- 3. Upper Bumper Cover
- 4. Left Front Fender

When inspecting for contact make sure the van is on flat level ground or a drive on hoist. A frame supporting hoist can allow the body/frame to flux and the contact area may be missed. Also a visual inspection of the left to right front bumper alignment may reveal the contact.

Recommendation/Instructions

To correct this concern, perform a left/right front bumper alignment.
