Subject: Flutter Or Rattle Type Noise From Front Of Vehicle While Driving

The following diagnosis might be helpful if the vehicle exhibits the symptom(s) described in this PI.

## Condition/Concern

A customer may comment that they have a rattle, clunk or flutter type noise coming from the front of the vehicle while driving. The dealership technician may have a difficult time isolating the source of the noise.

## **Recommendation/Instructions**

Inspect the upper radiator baffle for a loose or missing clip, See picture below for area of concern:



If no concerns are found with the baffle, proceed with using chassis ears on various components and locations of the vehicle to help isolate the area of the concern.
