PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

Subject: PROGRAM CLUSTER Message Present For 1 - 2 Seconds When Ignition Key Turned To Run Position

Models: 2013 GMC Acadia AWD

Built Prior To VIN 1GKKVRKD4DJ123190

The following diagnosis might be helpful if the vehicle exhibits the symptom(s) described in this PI.

Condition/Concern

A Program Cluster Message may be present when the ignition key is turned to the run position for approximately 1 second and then the cluster will operate in a normal fashion.

Recommendation/Instructions

This concern may be caused by incomplete programming of the IP Cluster during assembly of the vehicle.

Note: Only AWD models built prior to the VIN reflected above have the potential for this condition.

This issue can be corrected by programming the cluster with the service calibrations available through SPS.

On vehicles received at the dealer built before the VIN breakpoint, they should be inspected for this condition at PDI and perform the repairs necessary to correct this condition prior to retail sale.
