# PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

#### Subject: Click Noise or Bump Felt in Steering

#### Models: 2012-2013 Chevrolet Corvette (All Models)

#### **Condition/Concern**

Some customers may comment on a click noise or a bump felt in the steering wheel when initiating a turn.

This may be caused by the magnet being loose and slightly moving as the steering gear is rotated.

#### **Recommendation/Instructions**

Disconnect the electrical connector from the steering gear (access from the bottom of the vehicle) and test to determine if the noise/feel is gone. If this corrects the condition, replace the steering gear.

If the noise/feel is present with the electric power disconnected, disconnect the intermediate shaft from the gear and test again. If the noise/feel is present with the intermediate shaft connected, inspect for the cause in the steering column.
