### Condition

Customer may report transmission warning lamp illuminated in instrument cluster. **DTC P074100** (Torque Converter Clutch Circuit Performance or Stuck Off) is stored in TCM.

### **Technical Background**

Diagnostic error in TCM software.

### **Production Solution**

### Service

- 1. Complete GFF. If **DTC P074100** is the only fault stored in TCM, continue below. If other faults are stored, this TSB does *not* apply and continue with fault diagnosis by normal process.
- 2. Check the freeze frame data as follows: *Vehicle Self Diagnosis >>Vehicle On Board Diagnostic >>02 Gearbox Electronics>> 004 DTC Memory >>004.01 Check DTC Memory >> Select Environmental Conditions* this will bring up a list of values. Scroll down, read and record transmission oil temp.

- 3. Clear fault codes and test drive.
- 4. If original freeze frame data shows fault was set at greater than 140°F (60°C), or if the fault returns after being cleared, create a TAC ticket, attach the GFF log along with the freeze frame data and call into Technical Assistance Center.
- 5. If freeze frame data shows the fault was set with transmission oil temp at 140°F (60°C) or less, this is a known concern and there is no repair available at this time. Instruct the customer that this condition is known, and a solution is under development and has no influence on performance or driving behavior.
